#### ANNUAL REPORT 2010

#### **Client Visits:**

During 2010 our volunteers made 318 visits to clients in our area. Most of the visits were to distribute food hampers along with vouchers for fresh milk, meat and produce. When needed, we also gave out vouchers for clothing and bedding from the pro-life thrift shop, bus tickets and assisted with a wide variety of other requests.

## **Christmas Hampers:**

Of course this is one of our major activities! We distributed 70 hampers with food, vouchers, and gifts for each man, woman and child on the list. We were helped by many volunteers and want to thank each and everyone of you who helped in any way to make this possible. We thank the students of Immaculata Regional High School who raised money through a "Fast" and the teachers who assisted with deliveries and provided a lunch on delivery day. Also thank you to the Knights of Columbus for their assistance.

## **Good News Bear Campaign:**

We appreciate your generous donations made on our behalf to the Good News Bear Campaign on CHBC-TV.

## Kids' Kapers:

Through this program we were able to help children from families in need to take part in a sport or recreational activity such as soccer, art, gymnastics, swimming, etc.

## **Summer Camp:**

Last year we were able to send ten children to summer camps at Camp Owaissi on the west side of Okanagan Lake which gives them an unforgettable summer experience.

#### **Snowflake Tea:**

In January we host a special afternoon tea at Sutherland Hills Rest Home. We provided a light lunch and entertainment and spent the afternoon visiting with the residents. They enjoy it very much. As well a couple of volunteers visited every month to conduct Communion Services.

#### **Ozanam House:**

We provided some financial support for this special project which was developed through the co-operation of all the conferences of the Central Okanagan. This past year we sponsored an Education/Bursary Fund for clients to further their educational goals.

### **Request for Furniture:**

For the past 2 years we shared a self storage unit for furniture with other SSVP conferences in Kelowna in order to accept donations of furniture and then to distribute it to people in need. This requires a co-ordinator and without one we may have to close it.

### Twinning in Peru:

Our conference is twinned with the Virgen Milagrosa Conference in Peru. We correspond with them and support them with our prayers and a financial donation which assists them in their works of charity.

#### Help for Haiti:

We sent a contribution to help following the devastating earthquake in Haiti in February of last year - a donation through Development and Peace and also through our National Office of SSVP which has direct links to conferences in Haiti.

#### **Vegetable Garden:**

A few hardworking volunteers planted and tended a vegetable garden last summer. Despite competition from marmots, deer and gophers the harvest yielded 2000 pounds of produce! This was donated to the Kelowna Food Bank for distribution as many of our clients make use of the food bank as well.
