

About Grief to Grace

Grief to Grace is a four to five day psychological and spiritual journey providing safety and support for anyone who has suffered degradation or violation through physical, emotional, or sexual abuse or neglect. It is appropriate for those who have endured rape, incest, or other forms or traumatic violation in childhood, adolescences, or as an adult. It is also suitable for those who have suffered abuse by a member of the clergy. This model of care provides therapy for the soul. The program is designed to help you experience the love and support of the suffering body of Christ as you journey through the Pascal mystery of your own life.

This effective healing process combines Living Scripture with journaling, group activity and discussion, therapeutic facilitation, cognitive restructuring and grief work. It is a pilgrimage to discover the love, tenderness, belonging, safety, joy and peace that are often missing from the stories of abuse victims.

Centering Prayer is a simple method of Christ-centered silent prayer, a renewal of an ancient Christian contemplative practice, updated for our time. It is not intended to replace other forms of prayer but can lead toward a deeper prayer life, increased intimacy with God, and spiritual transformation.

The Centering prayer method is simple. To begin, an experienced practitioner outlines the guidelines, giving time for participants to experience the process and respond with questions or comments. Following this introduction, individuals are encouraged to include Centering Prayer times as part of each day's routine. In addition, as a support or incentive to continue with this prayer, regular attendance in a Centering Prayer group is recommended to further establish and strengthen the practice. In time, all these lead to a deeper relationship with God and greater connection with all Creation.






