HISTORY OF THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS During the Turkish occupation of the Holy Land in the late Middle Ages, when pilgrims were prevented from visiting its sacred sites, the custom arose of making replicas of these Holy Places, where the faithful might come and pray. One of the most popular of these devotions was the "Stations of the Cross", which were imitations of the "stations", or stopping places of prayer on the Via Dolorosa in Jerusalem. By the late sixteenth century the fourteen stations, as we know them today, were erected in almost all Catholic churches.

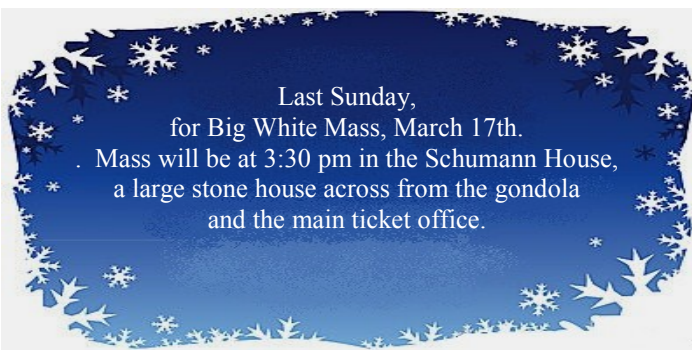

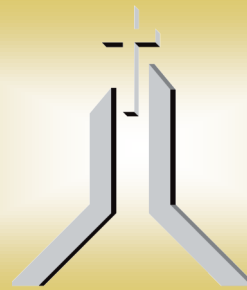

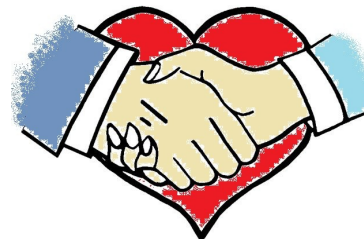
