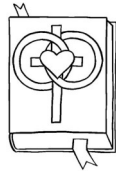

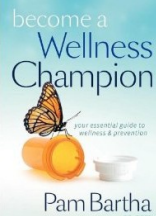
19TH ANNUAL 'WAY OF THE CROSS' WALK

Kelowna KAIROS, the Central Okanagan Ministerial, and a number of Kelowna churches and agencies are once again participating in a Good Friday 'Way of the Cross' journey through downtown Kelowna on March 29. Participants will gather in First United's sanctuary by 12:30 p.m. Following a reflection and prayer, members of the procession will carry a large wooden cross as they walk to a series of locations representing local organizations that deal with social issues in today's society. This year's route will include stops at several "former" locations of services such as the Women's Centre and Department of Immigration, noting government funding cuts that have reduced programs and services in critical areas. Downtown Urban Health will also be a stop on the route where the group will consider the impact of the announced closure of Cross Roads.

This event recognizes the work of local organizations in lifting up the struggles of many people in our city who carry the cross in our present time. It is a time of prayer, witness and song as the procession stops and listens to words from the agencies as well as the churches.

The walk will conclude at approximately 2:00pm, back at First United, where light refreshments will be available. All are welcome.

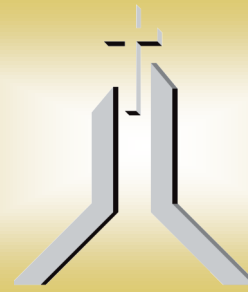

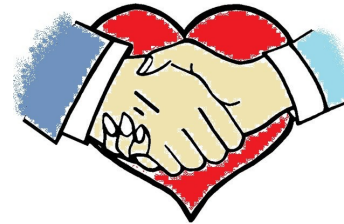
