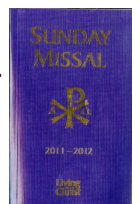


## PALM SUNDAY SERVICE

Canadian Food for Children was begun in the Kelowna in April 2004. Many wonderful volunteers have been involved and thousands of boxes of supplies have been sent to the distribution area in Langley. Diamond Delivery has been shipping our goods free all these years and we are deeply grateful to them. However the time has come when they can no longer provide us with this service. Because we are all volunteers we do not have the resources to pay for shipping so we have reluctantly decided to close. We have also enjoyed the use of a warehouse provided by Paul Leineman rent free.

CFCC needs continue more than ever as they are now negotiating with the Canadian Dairy Commission to purchase milk powder to provide for a cup of milk a day to 22 schools and 9 orphanages in Haiti as well as bringing relief to starving people around the world.

100% of all monetary donations are used to buy food and pay shipping costs and all donations go directly to those in need. We hope that the Kelowna area will continue to support CFCC with monetary support. ## O.F.F. WORKSHOP

The Office of Faith Formation is presenting a workshop called: **On Good Soil - Pastoral Planning for Evangelization and Catechesis with Adults**. This program will launch an approach to ministry endorsed by the Canadian Conference of Bishops and rooted in the Canadian culture. It gives us a new lens through which all adult faith formation in our parishes will be used. This type of directive from the CCCB only comes every eight or ten years. The workshop will include relevant reflection, constructive suggestions and sound orientations for effective, life-giving evangelizing and catechetical ministry with adults. Anyone who works in adult formation is encouraged to attend.

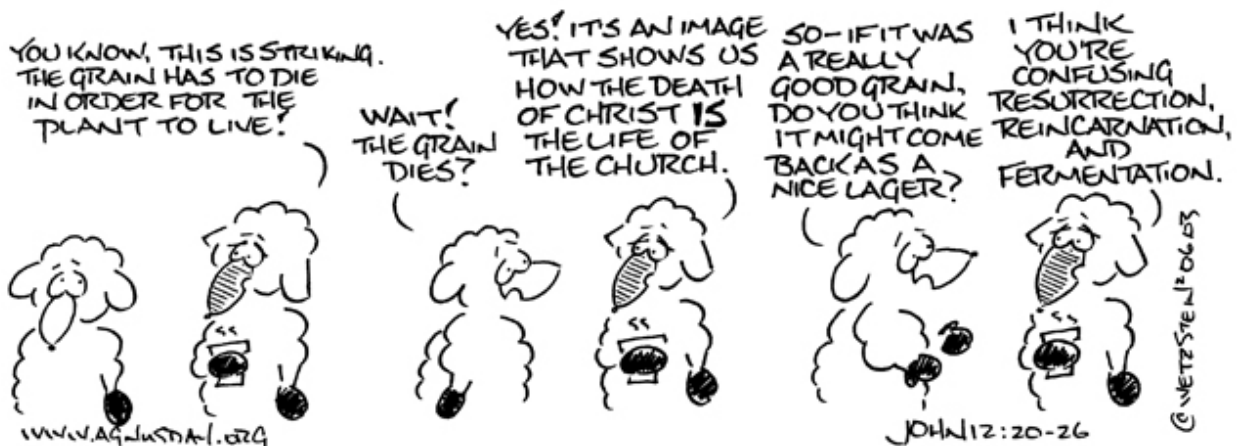
