PASTOR'S MESSAGE

With the Parable of the Prodigal Son and the Woman Caught in Adultery, the next two Sundays focuses our attention on the mercy of God and the gift of reconciliation. These two stories have also been our focus in our Lenten Prayer and our desire "to be more mindful of (God's) mercy in our lives" and our call to extend God's "forgiveness to those who have injured us."

Our Lenten reflection booklets have also focused our thoughts on the role of reconciliation in our relationship with God and with others. Though we may tire of asking for forgiveness or tire of forgiving others, God never tires of showing his mercy towards us. Let us make it our aim this Lent to approach him once again to celebrate this great gift of his and let us also seek forgiveness from at least one person.

Thursday, April 4th marks the date for our Lenten Communal Penitential Service. A number of priest will be available to celebrate our faith in God's mercy. Come and support one another by your presence. We will also pray that God may root out all sin from the Church, especially those sins committed against the young, the powerless and the vulnerable.

In preparation for our Lenten Communal Penitential Service, I offer the following brief examination of conscience:

1. How have I fallen short of God's call in my life?
 2. What is the sin that troubles me the most?
 3. What is holding me back from celebrating God's mercy or offering forgiveness to someone who needs it most?
- If we all spend five minutes reflecting on each one of these questions, asking God to show us the truth, I am confident God will be faithful in his response.


Stations of the Cross


ST. PIUS X KNIGHTS BREAKFAST CANCELLED

It is the third Sunday of Lent, and while this Sunday's Gospel is encouraging us to be fruitful, let's consider also the following day's solemnity,

The Annunciation of the Lord!

Gabriel comes to tell Mary that she, a young virgin, will bear a child of the Holy Spirit who will be the Son of God. *How would you respond?*

Mary was troubled, but answered, "*Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word.*"



The fruit of Mary's 'yes' was the birth of our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

Jesus was teaching the crowds; some of those

Luke 13:1-9

present told Jesus about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices.

Jesus asked them, "Do you think that because these Galileans suffered in this way that they were worse sinners than all other Galileans? No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all perish as they did. Or those eighteen who were killed when the tower of Siloam fell on them – do you think that they were worse offenders than all the others living in Jerusalem? No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all perish just as they did."



Then Jesus told this parable: "A man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came looking for fruit on it and found none. So he said to the gardener, 'See here! For three years I have come

looking for fruit on this fig tree, and still I find none. Cut it down! Why should it be wasting the soil?'


"The gardener replied, 'Sir, let it alone for one more year, until I dig around it and put manure on it. If it bears fruit next year, well and good; but if not, you can cut it down.'

If I actually had to expect a message from the worst fiends of an inferno, there is nothing I should expect so much as the message that everything is bright and breezy, happy and comfortable, and that there is no peril on the path of man. (G.K. Chesterton)

Often we pray for things which will make us comfortable – health, wealth, friends, security. Sometimes when we experience pain in one of these areas, we are tempted to shake our fists at God and ask, "Why me?"

Comfort can lead to apathy, as Jesus is trying to explain to his crowds. "Repent!" he says instead. Change direction! Look beyond what you have, to see what you have not.

The fig tree has all it needs but still does not bear fruit? How does the discomfort of Lent help us?



Why is Jesus referring to these disasters as he speaks to the crowds?

The Jews believed "bad luck" was the result of sin. If something terrible happened to someone, it might be because they had angered God.

What is Jesus telling me?

But Jesus tells them this is not true. Everyone sins, and everyone needs to repent. Nobody knows for certain when our time will end, and Jesus urges us not to wait. Everyone has a choice to make now – Repent!

Lent is our opportunity to kick-start a spiritual life which might not be bearing fruit right now. It is an invitation to look at what we have been given, and how we have, or have not, been using those gifts for God and for others as he commanded us to do.

What good things have I received - talents, opportunities, material goods, salvation! Be specific.

Have these gifts been used well or wasted?

If I am the fig tree in this story, what has God provided to help me grow strong in my faith?

From the Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church

100. In what way is the spiritual motherhood of Mary universal?

Mary had only one Son, Jesus, but in him her spiritual motherhood extends to all whom he came to save. Obediently standing at the side of the new Adam, Jesus Christ, the Virgin is the *new Eve*, the true mother of all the living, who with a mother's love cooperates in their birth and their formation in the order of grace... (CCC 501-507, 511)

Having trouble with your Lenten fast? Try asking Mary to pray for you, for the gifts of obedience, courage, devotion and perseverance, so that your life will bear fruit as hers did, bringing Jesus into the world.




When you see "CCC" this refers to a numbered paragraph in the "Catechism of the Catholic Church", an easy-to-read reference about our Catholic faith. This is a handy book to have at home, and can also be found for free online at the Vatican's website www.vatican.va.

Spend 3 minutes. Try pulling out your Bible (really hope you have one!) **Read Isaiah 58:6-12.** That's the book of Isaiah, Chapter 58, verses 6 to 12. You can find Isaiah in the Old Testament. Isaiah had a lot to say about the kind of fast which pleases God, and the blessings it brings to us.

Here are the 12 fruits of the Holy Spirit. Place 3 of the fruits on your tree. What are you doing over Lent to encourage this fruit to grow?
