
This fund is set up to help families who require some financial help so that their children can access programs that are fun, healthy, educational or creative.

In order to clear up any confusion about Income Tax receipts for donations made to Ozanam House or to Saint Vincent de Paul at St. Charles Garnier, may we offer the following explanation:

Both organizations are works of charity in the name of Saint Vincent de Paul. The group of Vincentians at our Parish, known as a Conference, is celebrating twenty-five years of service to the poor in Southeast Kelowna. This service is offered to all who request help, without regard to race, creed, gender, or age. With the help of your generous donations, the Conference provides emergency food hampers, Christmas hampers and gifts, and occasionally will pay a hydro bill when there is a threat of the power being cut off. Through the co-operation of the Pro-Life Thrift store, clothing and household goods are also provided.

Ozanam House, a 19-bed facility on Richter Street, was named in honour of Blessed Fréderic Ozanam, the founder of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul. As an organization, it is known as the "Society of Saint Vincent de Paul of the Central Okanagan". The House provides Home, Health, and Hope for males who are recovering addicts, alcoholics, or mentally ill. It is supported by our K of C, CWL, parish council, and the six SSVP conferences in the Okanagan: St. Ann, Penticton; Our Lady of Lourdes, West Kelowna; St Pius X, Glenmore; Immaculate Conception, City Central; St Theresa, Rutland; and St Charles Garnier, Southeast Kelowna. Some parishioners donate to Ozanam House through the "1001 Nights Campaign" and some do so through Despite this, and government support www.CanadaHelps.Org. through BC Housing grants, the House faces an annual funding shortfall.

ICC PARISH MISSION

ICC PARISH MISSION—MARCH 23 TO MARCH 26

From March 23 to the 26, Bishop Carlos Sevilla, SJ, Bishop Emeritus of the Diocese of Yakima, will preach a Parish Mission at Immaculate Conception Parish. All masses of the weekend of March 21/22 will be celebrated with Bishop Carlos. Weekday Masses March 23 to 26 will be moved from 8:00 am to 11:00 am with the Mission Talk and the same Talk will be given at 7:00 pm without the celebration of Mass.

Bishop Sevilla was born on August 9, 1935 in San Francisco, California, and entered the Society of Jesus, more commonly known as the Jesuits in 1953. Bishop Sevilla was ordained to the priesthood on June 3, 1966. He made his solemn profession as a Jesuit on April 22, 1974.

On December 6, 1988 Bishop Sevilla was appointed an Auxiliary Bishop of San Francisco, California by Pope John Paul II. He was ordained a bishop on January 25, 1989 by Archbishop John R. Quinn, now Archbishop emeritus of San Francisco. On December 31, 1996 Bishop Sevilla was named the sixth bishop of Yakima. On May 31, 2011, when the seventh bishop of Yakima was installed, Bishop Sevilla became Bishop Emeritus of the Diocese of Yakima. After consultation with the Jesuit Order, he continues to live in Yakima, helping his successor in the ministries of the diocese. He also is very active as a spiritual director, giver of retreats and conferences within the diocese and beyond as well as the Episcopal Advisor for the National Cursillo Movement.
