PASTOR'S MESSAGE

As you well know, St. Charles Garnier will be welcoming a Catholic Refugee Family from Pakistan. Our family consists of three adult children, their mother, two spouses and five young children. They have undergone years of persecution, including repeated death threats from a radical religious group and torture by rogue police officers because of their work in human rights. They were forced to flee to Thailand in 2012, only to find themselves among a growing group of refugees that are unwelcomed and in constant danger of deportation.

They will be arriving in Canada on June 6th and we have found them a nice home to live. The cost of housing, feeding and providing for such a large group of people is not cheap. The total bill will run around \$70,000. Though we have some initial funds, we are appealing to the community for any help they can give, especially in regards to money, good quality furniture and some help to make the house ready for occupancy (a good cleaning). We are trying to organize a cleaning spree sometime early next week, so if you can help please contact our office at 250-860-6776. A pledge form will also be available before and after each Mass and at the Parish Office for those who want to make a pledge to Fr. Bart's Bike Ride up the Pennask Summit.

A final update on bequest money dispersed thus far: \$3,500 to Pro-Life for a Fetal Heart Monitor for KGH, \$8,000 to St. Vincent de Paul for a housing solution program called "Invincible Housing", and \$13,500 to Ozanam House for Counselling Services. We continue to encourage our parishioners to donate to these and other worthy causes.

I would also like to remind everyone of our Parish Mission beginning next weekend at all Masses and continuing from Monday, May 28th to Thursday, May 31st beginning at 7 pm. Please support our parish Mission by your attendance and by inviting a family member or friend. A Parish Mission is a great way to be renewed in one's own faith and to get re-connected after a period of absence. We welcome anyone that would like to attend, regardless of their parish of origin or their religious affiliation. "Come and See," said the Lord.




