PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dearly Beloved Sisters and Brothers in Christ!

The Name of Jesus!

A few days back one of our parishioners asked me to explain the 'meaning of Jesus'. This individual also said why don't we call him 'Jehovah?'

Jehovah comes from the Hebrew root word (EL SHADDI) 'Yahweh' which is the personal name of God for the Israelites. The name Yahweh occurs 6700 times in the Bible. This could explain its importance. But the Israelites were afraid of pronouncing this name for fear of punishment by the Deity.

Moses asked God to reveal his name (Ex 3:13-14) God replied, "I am who I am" which is explained as the 'One who causes to be' (He is the Creator God who causes everything to be, sustains life, performs stupendous miracles to save his people)

The name of Jesus comes from the Hebrew root word 'YESUVA' and Israelites shortened it to "Yesu' which gives the meaning 'the one who saves'. Yesuva means 'Salvation or God who saves'. Jesus is the personal name and Acts 4:12 affirms this concept ' He will save his people from their sins'.

Christianity is the half shoot of Judaism. We have deep roots with the Hebrew heritage. While we honor their God's affiliation we would like to honor the saving acts of Jesus because of His great love for his people. The Eucharist we celebrate daily in his remembrance actualizes His nearness & closeness to all faithful.


