Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ!

The Month of May is dedicated to Saint Joseph the Worker. "He was a man of honor" (Mathew 1:19) He lived a virtuous life following the principles of God. Sometimes we have heard the expression 'he was a just man' because he was not puffed up with pride or over-confidence. (Col 2:4) He was truthful and was not too quick to jump into conclusion on anything but he waited on God for clarity & guidance.

Two great Popes of our modern times have reflected on the life of St. Joseph and have penned their wonderful thoughts in their Encyclicals. Pope Leo XIII in his 'Rerum Novarum' ((Rights & Duties of Capital & Labor) wrote that 'work is a human right' and so he voiced his opinion for a just wage, family, and hourly wage. On behalf of the Church he decried the modern practices of capitalism & helped the nations to treat workers with equity & respect.

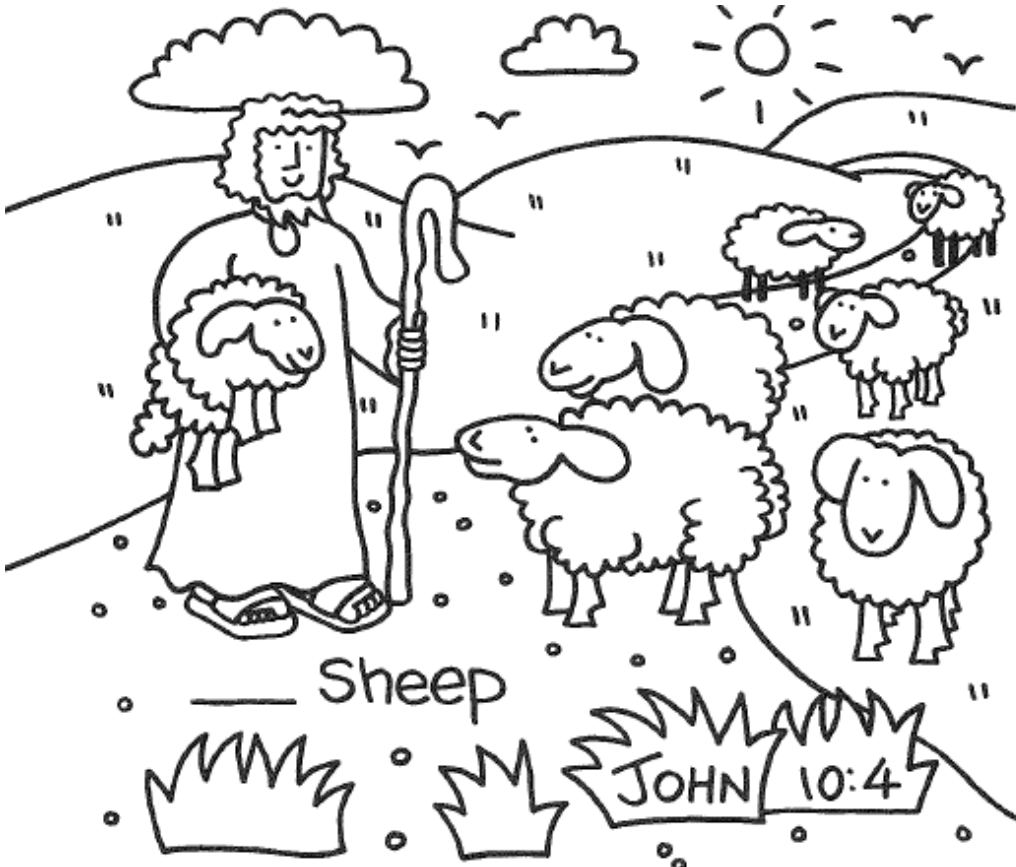
