The Month of May is dedicated to Saint Joseph the Worker. "He was a man of honor" (Mathew 1:19) He lived a virtuous life following the principles of God. Sometimes we have heard the expression 'he was a just man' because he was not puffed up with pride or over-confidence. (Col 2:4) He was truthful and was not too quick to jump into conclusion on anything but he waited on God for clarity & guidance.

Two great Popes of our modern times have reflected on the life of St. Joseph and have penned their wonderful thoughts in their Encyclicals. 
