PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Our Homecoming Celebration coincides with the feast of Pentecost and the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and upon the early Christian community. It was a time for new beginnings, a time when the church sprung forth from the tomb and became a living witness of the Resurrection of our Lord.

Many of our brothers and sisters, neighbours and friends, are being called to respond to God's gift of the Spirit anew. Some may need healing, others encouragement and support, while others may need answers to their questions. Though we trust that God's Spirit has been active in moving them to conversion, as he is at work in us, God is calling us to make his invitation concrete.

During the next two weeks I ask that you intensify your prayers asking for the Holy Spirit's help and guidance in extending the invitation in a way that builds on what he is doing in the person's life. You may have a particular person in mind. Pray for them by name. Pray also for how God may be asking you to contribute to the Homecoming Celebration itself; be it in the bright colours we are inviting everyone to wear (it is the feast of Pentecost after all), a food item that you can bring to enhance the social time after the 8:30 am Mass or a salad dish to complement the barbeque we are having after the 10:30 am celebration, a special gift of ministry or by your willingness to greet or extend a welcome to those who are moved to come. A special sign-up sheet will be made available in the foyer so that we have a clearer idea who is bringing food items and who is willing to help with the set-up and clean up. Thank you in advance for your participation and enthusiasm.

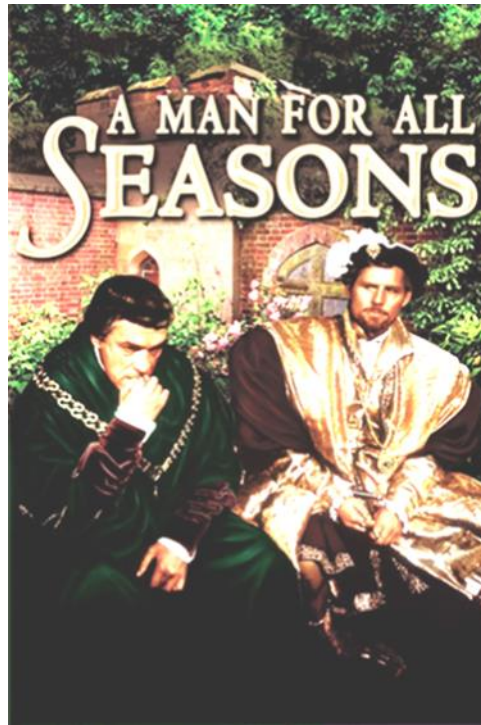
