#### **USHER NEWS**

...continued from last week.

When ushers walk to the head of an aisle, either to begin the collection or to present the gifts, there is no need to venerate the sanctuary or the presider (Fr Wayne.) If your sense of propriety demands some gesture keep it reverent but discreet (e.g. a pause with a simple head bow.) Genuflections and 'great' bows have a place in our worship, but not here. This restraint may be difficult but, remember, the ministry is not a statement of our personal devotion, we are acting as official ministers of the Church and as such make every effort to conform our actions to the dictates of the ministry (as set out by our pastor and liturgy committee.)

Do not rush the collection. Undoubtedly there will be parishioners unprepared when you arrive with the basket. Your countenance should always be one of cordiality and graciousness. At the ushers meeting stories were recounted of individuals chasing after the ushers to make their donation. Though we don't want to dawdle, no one should ever feel rushed or overlooked by us.

Whether we are greeting fellow parishioners or collecting the gifts we are acting as ministers of the Church in a ministry that is as holy and essential to the liturgy and the "building up of the community" as any other. Thank you!
