CATHOLIC CHRISTIAN OUTREACH UPDATE

Dear Parishioners of St. Charles Garnier Parish,

It was little over a year ago that I asked for your help in supporting my 4 month mission with Catholic Christian Outreach in Victoria, BC. With 26 other young adults from across Canada, I spent my summer as part of the IMPACT mission team. On mission we led faith studies in our parishes, organized youth and young adult events with worship and speakers, did community outreach on the streets of downtown Victoria, and even led Adoration in St. Andrew's Cathedral - twice! My time on mission was challenging, exhausting, but so fruitful. I learned so much about abandonment to the Spirit and loving



people where they are at. Most of all, I learned how Christ is calling each of us to be missionary in our own unique way.



Near the end of mission I found an excitement growing in my heart to be a missionary on my home campus - UBC Okanagan. Catholic Christian Outreach's predominant work is evangelization on Canadian university campuses, and I decided to become a part of that mission. And so, with two other students, I set out to share the gospel at UBCO through the FOCUS (Fellowship of Catholic University Students) Club. We held an Advent retreat at Seton House of Prayer,

led weekly faith (bible) studies, hosted mass on campus once a month, hosted two pub nights, went skating and snowshoeing, and even held Stations of the Cross in the woods behind St. Charles. All I can say is -GOD IS SO GOOD! It was incredible watching the Spirit working in the hearts of our members, and mine too. He taught me so much about letting go and letting the Spirit use me, and trusting that it will all work out according to His plan.

And so, I am very happy to say that the FOCUS Club is planning for an even greater year this upcoming September. Unfortunately I won't be able to be a part of

the Club Executive this year, as I will be attending UBC Vancouver to begin the Midwifery degree program. However, I am so very excited for our new Club Executives as they continue Christ's mission at UBC Okanagan.

Thank you again for all of your support and prayers this past year - it has meant more than you know.
