

NEW VERSION OF SAFE ENVIRONMENT POLICY

The Safe Environment Policy was reviewed, revamped and revised. Bishop John Corriveau put into effect the latest version of the Safe Environment Policy on October 7, 2014. The third version of the policy more clearly states what is required, who has to follow the policy and



how it is implemented. And it accomplishes these things in fewer pages than the previous version.

Nearly two years ago, the previous version was published. Since then, the pastors, principals and safe environment coordinators have been working diligently to implement the policy. Thank you to the many volunteers and employees who participated in the training and provided criminal record checks to meet the policy requirements.

All of us need to be aware of the potential for abuse and the preventive measures being taken in the Diocese; the more people are aware of warning signs, the less likely it is for abusers to succeed. 

GIVING THANKS COOK-OFF

It was time to take down the Thanksgiving decorations! The display was comprised of pumpkins, winter squash, gourds, lots of rosemary and Hungarian peppers - hot!!!

Throwing away these "gems" would be a sin. So, two teams of enthusiastic cooks will take turns - this weekend Nov 1st and, then again, next weekend Nov 8 - transforming the beauty of this Fall's harvest into divine deliciousness.

The food will be donated to various organizations in the community: Kelowna Women's Shelter, Seton House of Prayer, Ozanam House, Freedom's Door, the Inn from the Cold and the Alexandra Gardner House Women's Shelter.
