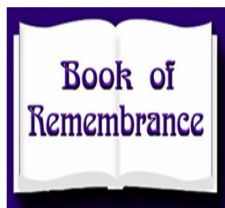

LADIES ADVENT REFLECTION

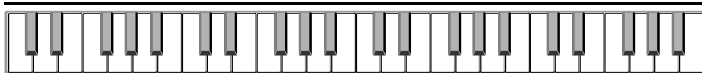

PILGRIMAGE OF FAITH APPEAL

NEW VERSION OF SAFE ENVIRONMENT POLICY

The Safe Environment Policy was reviewed, revamped and revised. Bishop John Corriveau put into effect the latest version of the Safe Environment Policy on October 7, 2014. The third version of the policy more clearly states what is required, who has to follow the policy and how it is implemented. And it accomplishes these things in fewer pages than the previous version.

Nearly two years ago, the previous version was published. Since then, the pastors, principals and safe environment coordinators have been working diligently to implement the policy. Thank you to the many volunteers and employees who participated in the training and provided criminal record checks to meet the policy requirements.

We encourage everyone to read the new policy – even those people who recently read the previous version. The new policy can be downloaded from the Safe Environment Office page on the Diocesan web site:

All of us need to be aware of the potential for abuse and the preventive measures being taken in the Diocese; the more people are aware of warning signs, the less likely it is for abusers to succeed. The Safe Environment Policy and training is about building a culture in our church and restoring trust in the church. The more people who understand the policy, the more we are united in creating a safe environment.
