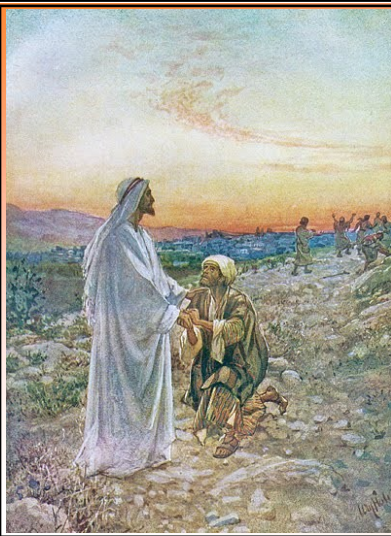

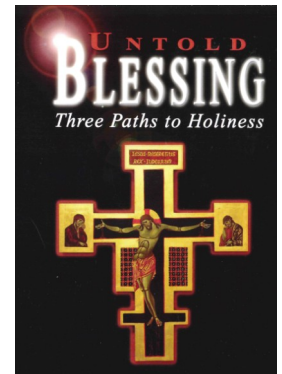
PILGRIMAGE OF FAITH

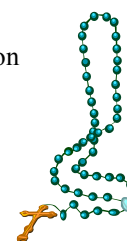

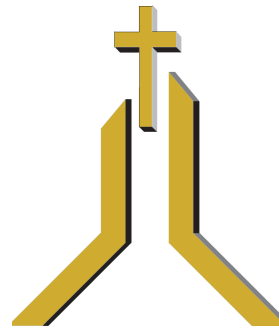

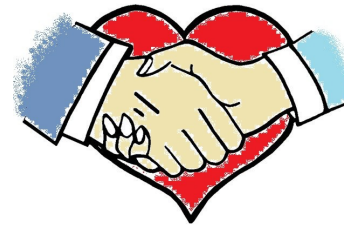
