During those nine days, I took the time to ponder and treasure all the people who shared my journey thus far, beginning with my own family and extending to friends, classmates, parishioners, Religious, priest, formators and bishops. The list is long. In these moments, and to this day, gratitude fills my heart, including for you, my dear parishioners. Thank you.

Now that the news of my appointment is public, my eyes are also beginning to turn to what lies ahead: the people of the Diocese of Corner Brook and Labrador. Please join me in praying for those to whom I am being sent, that the bond of love for one another may form and grow, that the preparations that lead up to the day of my ordination (Thursday, December 12th in Corner Brook, Newfound-land) may help to sow the seeds that bear fruit in years to come.

Thank you, Jerry, for the labour of love and care for our earth and our poor.


