FALL ADULT SERIES

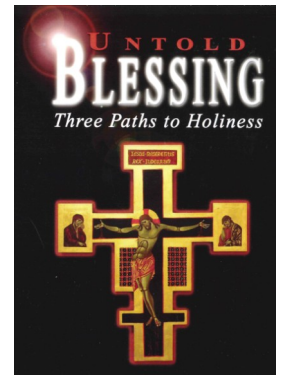
