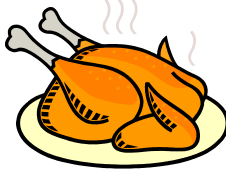

CHANGES TO THE LITURGY

The word Liturgy means "The work of the People". As you have heard, the mass as we know it is under construction. It is important to keep in mind that the changes that are being made are being directed by Pope Benedict and the Congregation for Divine Worship. Since most other languages translate from the English rather than the Latin, the Vatican felt that the English version of the Roman Missal, that directs how we offer mass, should be edited to better reflect what they are trying to express in the Latin edition of the Roman Missal.

We are a universal church, which means that the Catholic faith has been welcomed into every culture on the face of the earth, and so it is important that what we believe and what we profess be consistent in every language of the earth. It is my job and the job of Bishop John and the Diocesan Liturgy Committee and our local committee to help make the transition as smooth as possible. But change always has its price and so as the changes are introduced, if you have any questions I will do my best to answer them. I will speak to the specific changes in the weeks leading up to the first Sunday of Advent so that we are as prepared as we can be to join the Church in this new adventure. In the meantime, say a prayer for those who do not like change of any kind and say a prayer for people like me who are trying to make the changes easy for everyone.

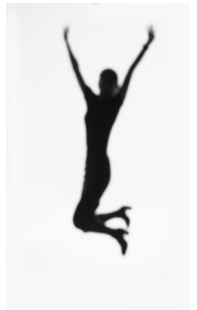
