## OUR PILGRIMAGE OF FAITH

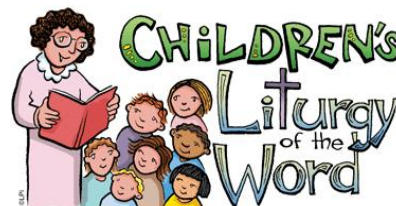
