## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

"Canadian Catholics are being called upon as citizens to exercise the right to vote". Thus, begins the brief guide published by Canadian Conference of Bishops published on their website: [ccb.ca](http://ccb.ca) Please take a moment to read it and to familiarize yourself with the various Catholic principles that are at play when assessing the various platforms and candidates.

The article begins by exhorting the faithful to vote and to act as responsible citizens. One should be reasonably informed of the major issues and the platforms that address it. The article also speaks of political candidates as men and women of good intent, concerned about the well-being of Canada and the public good.

The article reiterates that "while Christians beliefs do not constitute a political platform, they can be seen as a prism through which to analyze and evaluate government policies, laws, and programs". Starting out with the principle that upholds the dignity and respect of the human person from conception to natural death, it also asks us to apply the same principle when assessing policies dealing with "the weakest among us-physically, economically and socially," as well as the protection of minorities, the right to religious freedom and freedom of conscience.

The article addresses the principles of justice and solidarity when addressing issues such as First Nations, "prevention and treatment of addictions", education, health care, housing, respect and protection of the land, and international policies dealing with aid, peace and fair trade.

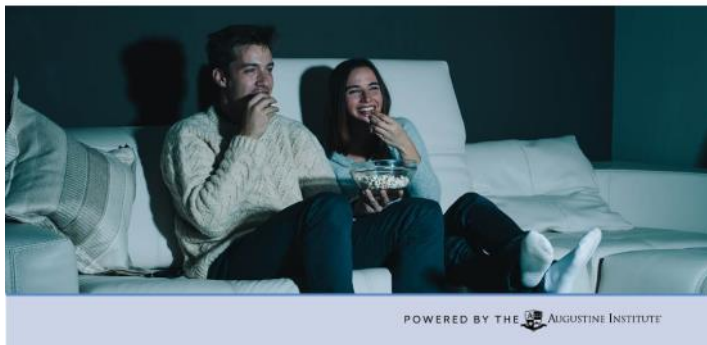

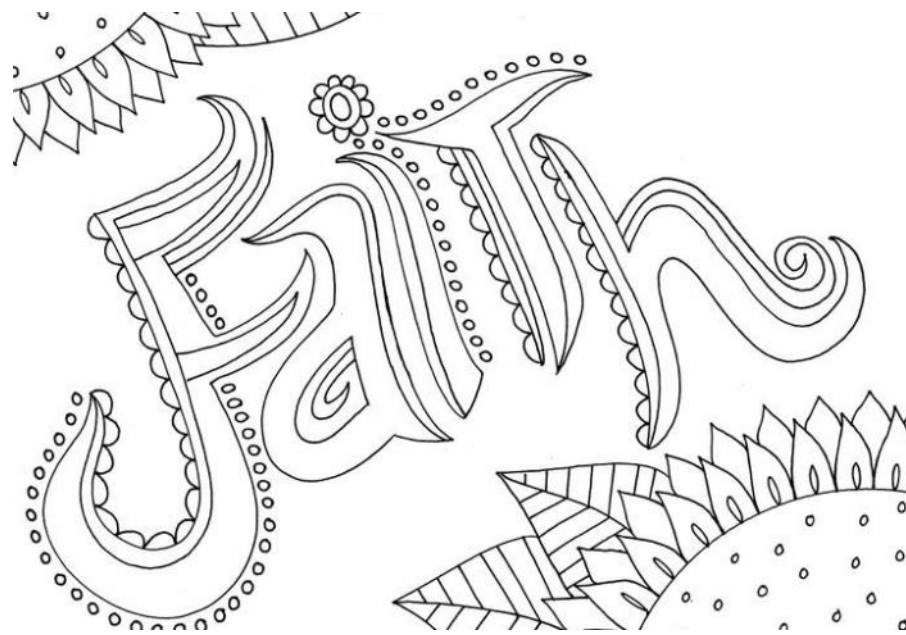
