

Franciscan Focus

Franciscans celebrate annually a ritual known as "Transitus". They celebrate the ending on earth of the life of Francis. Many creative rituals are designed for this celebration. It is generally held on October 3. Franciscans can design their own particular rituals for the Transitus.

Francis died on a Saturday evening, October 3, 1226. He was canonized two years later on July 16, 1228. Upon the completion of the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi, his body was buried there. His tomb is in the lower crypt of the Basilica. Francis spent his last days in praise of God and teaching his brothers. Celano writes of the ending of his life:

"He exhorted death itself, terrible and hateful to all, to give praise, and going forth joyfully to meet it, he invited it to make its lodging with him. 'Welcome', he said, 'my Sister Death.' To the doctor he said: 'Tell me bravely, Brother Doctor, that death, which is the gateway to life, is at hand.' then to the brothers: 'When you see that I am brought to my last moments, place me naked upon the ground just as you saw me the day before yesterday. And let me lie there after I am dead for the length of time it takes to walk a mile unhurriedly.'

The hour, therefore, came, and all the mysteries of Christ being fulfilled in him, he winged is way happily to God."




