



Dear friends,

Our trip to India this September was an incredible success! Linda, Dawn and I (Carol) were honoured to have travelled there, to teach the Indian women and to be able to present gifts from so many generous Canadians. We thank God that no one got sick and that we felt Divine protection when travelling on overcrowded streets during torrential rains and in flood conditions.

We were able to provide 40 new sewing machines on this trip. Some were given to women who are running small micro enterprises from their own homes and supporting their families. Others were given to schools and community centers to teach high school students, mothers and teachers how to sew.



We taught 216 girls and women (7 times in 6 different locations). Linda put special emphasis on teaching the women and girls how to make washable, reusable sanitary wear that will last for about four years and give them the ability to stay in school. I (Carol) taught on women's health and hygiene issues, modern day sex trafficking and self-defense for women. Linda and I performed skits which the women loved.

In the north we taught at New Life High School in Dehradun and a Christian Community Centre in Haridwar. In the south we taught students and teachers at the Holy Spirit EM High School in Atmakur, women at St. Mary's Church in Rayadurgam, Sisters and novices at Holy Spirit Sister's Mother House in a small community north of Hyderabad, and finally women at Fr. Bendel's Community Center in Hyderabad.



Overall we presented 309 Feminine Hygiene kits to the girls and women of India and taught them how to make their own in the future. We left a large bag of fabrics and supplies in every community, enabling them to start making kits immediately. We resourced fabric suppliers locally as well, for the future.

We also visited new Water wells in two communities in Divuru District.

We were overwhelmed by the gratitude of these communities, who showered us with the highest honour they could. We were escorted to the projects on wagons pulled by a tractor, with people playing drums and dancing, there were fireworks and we were given their small children to hold on our laps in the wagon. They had a ceremony for us at their local community Catholic Church and presented us with scarves and tea after many speeches and thanks.



A highlight of the trip was a fun afternoon playing with our children in Kalyandurg and presenting them with chocolates. We promised that clothing and shoes would follow in time for Christmas. They were excited to show us the wonderful gardens and trees that they had planted since our last trip.



We could not do this alone, and made sure they knew that many Canadians had given very generously to these projects. We thank you from the bottom of our hearts and bring thanks from all the women, children and communities who have benefitted from our projects.
