Pastor's Message:

I would like to thank all those who have generously donated to our diocesan Pilgrimage of Faith Appeal over the years. This annual appeal has allowed The diocese to receive the necessary support to help fund a variety of initiatives and programs that help all parishes and establish a greater sense of solidarity among all our parishes.

For the majority of its existence the Pilgrimage of Faith Appeal has run from October 1st to September 30th. 




