This puzzle is based on Luke 16:19-31 (NIV)





#### **CHANGES TO PILGRIMAGE OF FAITH APPEAL**

September 2019

To: The Faithful of the Nelson Diocese

For a number of years, the Pilgrimage of Faith Appeal has been running from October 1 to September 30<sup>th</sup>. The timing of the appeal has led to numerous challenges on many levels, especially when it comes to adhering to Revenue Canada guidelines and expectations.

A review of the timing of donations to the appeal show that the majority of donations are received during October to December. We believe that this has more to do with maximizing one's charitable tax receipts than the timing of the launch of the POF Appeal. By starting the appeal in January, many difficulties currently being experienced are removed. **Donors can still donate at any time during the year at a time that is convenient for them.** 

The current campaign will end on September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019. During the months of October – December 2019, there will be no active campaign due to the realignment of the appeal to January 2020.

For the balance of 2019, if you choose to donate during the October – December months, your donation will be gratefully accepted for the benefit of diocesan programs.
