Pastor's Message:

Late last Spring I was approached by some concerned parishioners who took the Food Safe Program. They wanted to make sure that the Kitchen was properly sanitized after each function. This includes K of C Breakfast, funeral luncheons, family nights, Sunday coffee, facility rentals and other times the kitchen is in use. We agreed, at that time, that the issue would be best addressed during the Fall when most of our functions take place.

We are therefore asking that every group that uses the kitchen and all those who find themselves cleaning up after events during the year to come to an evening workshop on Wednesday, Sept. 25th at 7:00 pm. Please discuss it at your monthly meetings to ensure a good attendance. By making sure everyone follows the same protocols in sanitizing the kitchen, we will ensure that health and well being of our parishioner and will satisfy the department of health codes.

For those outside groups that rent the facilities from us, an automatic surcharge for the kitchen will be applied and Romuald will make sure the kitchen is properly sanitized the next morning.

I would also like to inform all the groups in our parish and all those community groups that are interested that our annual Ministry Fair will be held the weekend of Oct. 19th and 20th. This is a wonderful time to show the parish what you are doing. Ask for volunteers and receive support from our parishioners. Please help us in making this Fall's Ministry Fair a great success.






