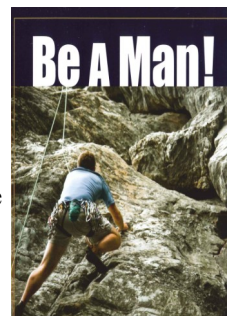

## BOUND4LIFE SILENT SIEGE

---

Bound4LIFE Kelowna is excited to announce our next Silent Siege is on Saturday, September 24th from 11am - 12pm at the Kelowna Court House.

We are continuing to pray for the end of abortion in Kelowna and the nation by petitioning the highest court in the land that God would end abortion and send revival to Canada. Come stand in the gap for our nation with us as we contend for LIFE in Kelowna.

We have been holding sieges over the last few months at the Kelowna Court House because we have started a 40 day Fast that is happening every Monday for a Supreme Shift in our nation. Eight of our nine Supreme Court Judges are eligible to retire and two have already retired since we started fasting and praying. We are asking God to appoint Canada's next righteous Judges. We are ushering this in with prayer and fasting petitioning heaven and standing on guard for Canada. ### PREVIOUS LIFE DECISIONS BY SUPREME COURT:

In 1988, the Supreme Court ruled in favour of Henry Morgentaler and struck down all laws and restrictions on abortion.

In 1989, the Supreme Court ruled that a biological father has no right to or say in whether his unborn child is aborted or not.

In both 2001 and 2003 respectively they ruled to keep euthanasia and assisted suicide illegal by upholding Robert Latimer's murder conviction (he killed his disabled daughter in a self-proclaimed "mercy killing") and by ruling against Susan Rodriguez's "right" to die by assisted suicide.

In 2008, they voted to give Henry Morgentaler the Order of Canada for his promotion of "women's health" - the highest honour a Canadian civilian can receive.

In 2010 they struck down parts of Canada's Assisted Human Reproductive Act, specifically the areas dealing with cloning, animal-human hybrids, and savior-siblings, ruling that it was up to each province to decide how to deal with these issues rather than the federal government. This means that whichever province is the most lenient will set the pace for the rest of Canada, rather than having a standard that every province must follow.

The Siege is not a protest, but a silent prayer meeting asking God for life, mercy, justice and to end abortion and send revival to our nation. Red tape with the word LIFE is placed over our mouths identifying with the voiceless child in the womb. ## FRIENDLY REMINDERS

**\*Friendly Reminder/Did you know?** We stand as a community now at all Masses when preparing to process for Communion. We do this not only because it is a procession but because if we stand for the Priest to enter or exit the celebration then we should certainly be standing when Jesus is fully present in the Eucharist! Remember the "good old days" when someone came into a room it was proper to stand and greet them out of respect? After you have received Communion you are welcome to assume whatever posture you choose for prayer.

Although, Church documents encourage Standing in Communion until the last person has received followed by a time of silence while or after the Blessed Sacrament is placed in the tabernacle, we have chosen a compromise so that if you would prefer to kneel after receiving you are invited to do that. Perhaps this is an opportunity to dialogue with your family about how you can approach this moment in the Mass with as much reverence as possible. If you are unable to stand or kneel due to your health, then this message does not apply to you because we don't expect you to do anything you cannot physically do.

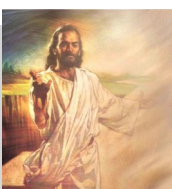

### QUESTION OF THE WEEK

**ADULTS:** Have I ever complained because God was generous to others who in my opinion did not deserve it?
