I know I cannot thank you enough for all that you have supported me with—both personally and for my community members through GROW— ever since I became part of your church community. If there is anything anywhere called blessing the other, making the world a better place to live and sharing unconditional love with those who need it, then it is right here in this church. You have shown it all.

On behalf of my community in Ghana and on my own, I wish to express my profound gratitude to you all for your compassion and generosity. I am touched by your kindness and deeply appreciate it. I thank you so much for your belief in me and my work. You inspire me to do more. I wish you all God's continued wonderful blessings and ask that you continue to pray for me and my community as I prepare to go back to Ghana and set up the clinic so that thousands of people can have access to health care to prevent unnecessary deaths. While there, I will continue to give you periodic updates on my work.




