Wow, from our event including all the food preparation, 4 large biodegradable bags - over 100 gallons, were picked up and delivered to a local composting facility. Nothing was wasted.

Here is more information on some of the topics addressed during the prize draw:

- **Ocean Wise** is a Vancouver Aquarium conservation program created to educate and empower consumers about the issues surrounding sustainable seafood. www.vanquaa.org/oceanwise
- **SPCA Certified** is an innovative farm certification and food-labelling program dedicated to improving farm animal welfare standards in Canada. www.sPCA.bc.ca/welfare/farm-animal-welfare
- **Phthalates** are a class of chemicals most commonly used as plasticizers or softening agents, among the most common fragrance ingredients in perfumes, personal care products and cosmetics; Phthalates are choice ingredients in cosmetics because they are cheap and versatile, and they make the fragrance linger. However, there is evidence that it interferes with hormone function. Phthalates have been linked to early puberty in girls, reduced sperm count in men, and reproductive defects in the developing male fetus (when the mother is exposed during pregnancy). www.davidsuzuki.org/issues/health/science/toxics
- **Parabens** - are preservatives used in approximately 75 to 90 percent of standard cosmetics and personal care products. Parabens can mimic estrogen, the primary female sex hormone. They have been detected in human breast cancer tissues. In addition, studies indicate that methylparaben applied on the skin reacts with UVB leading to increased skin aging and DNA damage. www.davidsuzuki.org/issues/health/science/toxics
- **WHY ORGANIC?** No chemicals - no GMO's - no GREED - and a good living can be made on an organic farm. The dream is to not have to distinguish between organic and conventional. All **healthy** food should be available to everyone. **Chemical-free** products should be the norm. We must stay informed and share the information. We must work for the common good. As servants of Christ it is our responsibility to share the GOOD NEWS, to speak the TRUTH of goodness, kindness, integrity, love, and compassion. For the good of all, we must be bold and become the voice for all. A future when wisdom and goodness prevails; and peace, prosperity, happiness and good health abound ...for the TRUTH will make us free.

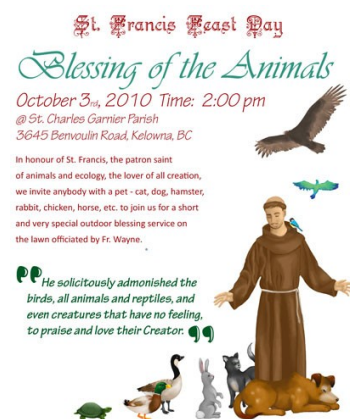

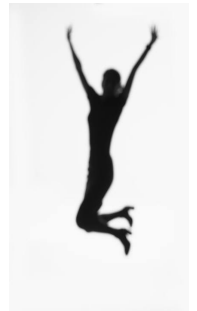
