





MISSIONARY UPDATE

Dear members of the St. Charles Garnier parish family:

Greetings from Ottawa! At Fr. Pat's invitation, I am sending periodic updates about my work as a full -time lay missionary with Catholic Christian Outreach (CCO). First and foremost, I wish to thank each and every one of you who are sponsoring me in this endeavour—prayerfully, financially, or both. The continued support of my parish community gives me great encouragement and is essential to my ability to respond to the Church's need for labourers in the New Evangelization.



In mid-August, I completed a week-long training here in Ottawa for new staff and my call here was affirmed in a very powerful way. Immediately after, we were joined by the rest of CCO's missionaries from across the country for our National Staff Gathering, where the vision and goals for the upcoming year were presented, discussed, and discerned.

Day-to-day, I'm based at our national headquarters in the Archdiocesan Pastoral Centre, where I'm working in Stewardship and Development and on special projects for the Finance team. Here in the office, I'm able to live out my call to mission in a more "hidden" way, using my education, skills, and experience to support (and intercede for) campus evangelization and to help lead the movement at the national and international level. I also have opportunities to engage in direct ministry, as well. This past weekend, for example, I joined the Ottawa district campus team in facilitating an annual Fall Retreat attended by approximately 75 university students from the area. Many of them experienced profound conversions and a deepening of their relationship with the Lord, especially during the evening of Eucharistic Adoration, Praise and Worship, and Reconciliation, which was the cornerstone of the retreat.

On a more personal note, I share a household with two CCO campus missionaries, Megan and Mallory, who tell me "glory stories" over dinner every evening about how the Holy Spirit is moving in the lives of our students. As you might imagine, September is a very busy time! On campus, CCO staff and student leaders invite others students to fill out a faith survey and leave their contact information. We follow-up with each contact directly, so that we can present the Gospel message, clearly and simply, to one person at a time. Students are then invited to join a faith study, which meets for one hour a week over the course of the semester. Each of our five faith studies (Discovery, Source, Growth, Obedience and Commission) is designed to bring people to Christ, build them up as Catholic Christians and send them out to reach others. I know that Andie, St. Charles' youth and young adult minister, is using CCO's faith studies as part of her campus ministry work at UBC's Okanagan campus. It brings me great joy to know that students there are being introduced to Jesus and drawn into Christian community through outreach efforts originating from our parish and connected to CCO!



QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Adults: Have I ever scandalized anyone with my behaviour at home, workplace or parish? What did I learn from the experience?
