PRAY WITH THE SAINTS OF CANADA FOR THE 150TH

Saint Marguerite d'Youville (1701-1771):

Saint Marguerite d'Youville was born in 1701 at Varennes, Quebec. She was married for eight years and had six children, (four died in infancy and two sons later became priests) before becoming a widow in 1730. She founded an order of religious women, the Sisters of Charity, commonly known as the Grey Nuns. With the Grey Nuns, she established hospitals in Montreal and across Canada. In 1871 the Grey Nuns founded the St. Boniface Hospital, located at the fork of the Red and Assiniboine Rivers. Marguerite died in 1771 and was canonized in 1990. Her feast is October 16.

We pray: Dear Saint Marguerite, you are known as Mother of the Poor. You knew and understood poverty from your own life experiences and by caring for those most in need. Within the community, you wanted "perfect union, with one heart and one soul, always considerate and supportive of each other in our weakness, knowing that we need a greater love to bear our own." Intercede for us, so that all Canadian citizens may be supportive in working towards making our country free of poverty by always being truly in perfect union. Amen.

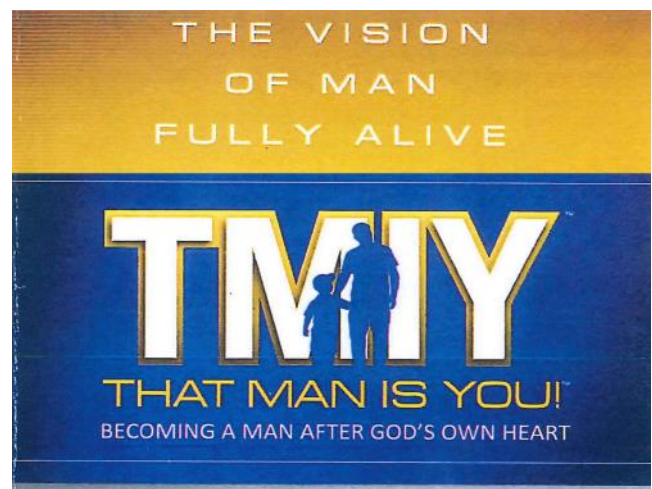

SEASON OF CREATION: Let's Play!

Ideas for Children, Youth, Families and the Young-at-Heart

Photo Safari

Go on a neighbourhood walk, looking for surprises you may have missed through over-familiarity with the area. Try to see the familiar with safari hunter eyes and to capture “trophies” with your cell-phone camera. If each family goes on a separate phot safari, it will be fun to compare trophy shots.

Treasure Hunt

Take a walk on the wild side, searching for treasures. Use all of your senses, not just your vision, to help you locate one object per person that moves you in some way. When the hunt has ended, share your treasure—either physically, if it's an object, or through words, if it's an experience such as the call of the loon — with the rest of the group, and tell what personal meaning your treasure has to you.

Parable Scavenger Hunt

Jesus loved to tell parables based on object from nature. How many parable items can you find?

Examples: a stalk of wheat, lilies of the field, a mustard seed, weeds among the grain, a vine with branches, “treasure” hidden in a field. If you don't find any items Jesus mentioned, select an original item. Spend some quiet time with the item, as Jesus clearly did. Let it tell you a story.

It's for the Birds

Attach a loop of wire or loop a long pipe cleaner to the end of a pinecone. Roll the pinecone in peanut butter and then in seeds. Hang your birdfeeder where you can enjoy watching the avian activity.

Awful to Awe-full

God has a habit of bringing good from what seems bad, as we're seeing in response to the wild-fires ravaging our province. For this game, someone starts a story in which something awful happens.

Subsequent story-tellers turn the story, bit by bit, into one of hope and awe. The final step is to make it happen. Select a local tragedy and do something concrete to give hope to those affected.
