

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Family Nights are quickly approaching and the momentum is slowly building. PRAY WITH THE SAINTS OF CANADA FOR THE 150TH

Saint Marguerite Bourgeoys (1620-1700):

Saint Marguerite Bourgeoys was born in France in 1620. In 1653 she left France and journeyed to what is present day Montreal. It was there she founded an order of religious women, the Congregation of Notre-Dame, and started a school. Marguerite dedicated her life to educating young girls, including the poor and Native American, about virtue, literature, and faith. She was canonized in 1982 and her feast is January 12.

We pray: Dear Saint Marguerite, you and your companions taught catechism and basics of literature, as well as virtue, etiquette and the love of work. You wrote, "It is true that what I have always wanted most, and most ardently desire, is for the great teaching of the love of God above all things and the love of one's neighbour as one would be loved, to be engraved on all hearts."
