PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Last week I asked the question: "What are you looking for in life?" Some people were taken aback by the question. One would hardly expect to be asked such a thing on the spur of the moment. And yet, that is what Jesus did. In the first chapter of John's Gospel, after John the Baptist points Jesus out to two of his disciples, Jesus turns around on seeing them come to him asking: "What are you looking for?"

The five most common answers were Peace (55), Happiness (38), Good Health (21), Love (17) and heaven/salvation (13). It was obvious that many of you meant different things by using any one of these words. I also wonder how your answers would have changed had I given you more time to think about it.

But it did get me thinking. Do we have a clear idea what we mean by peace or happiness? And does the way we live out life help in bringing it about? So often, we are run off our feet by all the demands we place on our lives. In this model, peace and happiness come at a considerable price, sometimes even at the expense of our health. Is there a simpler, more Christ-centered answer to the very things we are looking for?

Then I got to thinking about all the activities we've had around Laudato Si' and our place in Creation. Most of them involved cutting back, nature walks, prayer and getting together with others for discussion. Like the web of life at the entrance of our Church, these activities are more organic, informal and natural to who we are. As we enter into the routines of a new year, may we reflect on that which is helpful in bringing peace and happiness not only in our own lives, but for the health and well being of everyone.

PRAY WITH THE SAINTS OF CANADA FOR THE 150TH

Saint François de Laval (1623-1708):

St. Francois de Laval was born in 1623 in France and entered the local Jesuit college at the age of eight. He spent the next decade studying theology and became a priest in 1647. He was appointed the first bishop of New France when he was 36 and "is admired for his pastoral work among the Aboriginal Peoples and the settlers of New France, and for trying to defend Native People from being exploited by merchants and governors" (CCCB). He was canonized in 2014 and his feast day is May 6.

We pray: Dear Saint François, you were Québec's first shepherd, a good and brave man who was a key person in our country's social and religious history. You travelled on foot, by canoe and wearing snowshoes to visit and comfort many people. Intercede for us, so that all Canadian citizens may be inspired and never tire to find ways to live out acts of mutual forgiveness in homes and communities everywhere. Amen.


