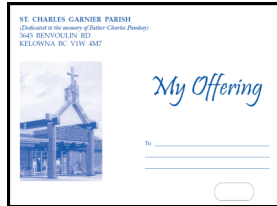


## VISITATION MINISTRY MEETING

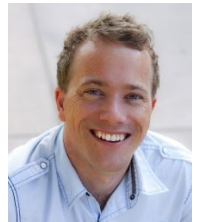

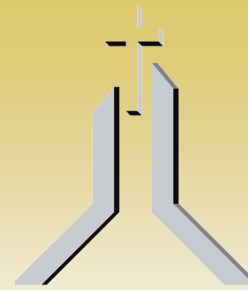
