Swith Sunday in Ordinary Time "If you choose, you can make me clean.""

Mark 1:40-45

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Jesus is the Divine Healer" Isaiah 53:4 "Surely he has borne our infirmities and carried our diseases. By his wounds we are healed". Mark 1:40 "If you choose you can make me clean". Christ the Lord can heal all our wounds, diseases, and ailments. His healing touch/power can save entire humankind. But there are those who still suffer with several of their unhealed & incurable diseases even though they have confided to Christ about them in their prayers. Why can't he heal my cancer/ Why can't he address my child's ailments? Why can't he bind my brokenness? Why can't He heal my weakness of body, mind, and spirit (especially my spiritual and moral sickness?)

The Gospel of Mark 1:40 repeats: "If you choose, you can make me clean". Apostle Mathew in his gospel narrates the story of a woman with a blood flow (hemorrhage). She had this blood flow for several years (about 12 yrs). She had met several medical persons/physicians for assistance. But none of them could help her find a cure. The Book of Leviticus 15:25 considered her unclean (ritually defiled). But she did not wish to disclose her identity. She was unwilling to come/approach Jesus publicly/ openly. So, she came from behind secretly and touched his garment. She came in fear and with great anxiety/in panic but with faith in her heart. She made a determination, 'If only I would touch his garment, I would be made well'. She developed this mindset and mustered strength to come out of her comfort zone and made an attempt to touch his garment.

What a surprise. She was instantaneously healed of her blood flow. Today's gospel praises her strong Will Power & Determination. It also encourages us to develop such stamina/similar faith to experience the healing touch of Christ the Lord in our lives.

WHO reports that there are about 600,000 leprosy cases attended to every year by medical experts. Leprosy/Hansen's disease is contained in our modern times... but there are numerous skin diseases in the world ...like 'Ebola, scabies & eruption of the skin, etc. We need to be careful to take care of our skin and of our people in a timely manner to get treated with our skin issues. Washing hands, sanitizing them, and keeping them from contamination are a few precautionary measures that we can take to help prevent skin diseases. Moreover, we need to have recourse to medical assistance if there's a need to address any challenge.

Hansen's disease along with temporary disorders or symptoms, are curable. Primitive hygiene considered such maladies as highly contagious and demanded complete isolation. Spiritually, the integrity of the body and soul is essential for religious worship. Otherwise, people are afflicted with these malignant symptoms... leading to religious and social ostracism such as the formant of evil forces & superstitious beliefs. Leprosy is contagious. It manifests itself in several forms through spreading, sores that result in discoloration of the surrounding areas of the skin, hair loss, skin blotches, sacbes resulting from boils or burns, scalp disorders, face eruptions, whiteness of the skin and so on. The priest acted not as a physician, but as an interpreter of the law to certify whether the person in question is clean or unclean. When in doubt a period of quarantine was imposed for a week or two. During such times the unclean person remained outside of town, wearing torn garments, crying repeatedly," unclean, unclean" to alert people not to come closer.

If we are so very careful about our skin disease, how much more we should be troubled with our disease of the soul, which is called 'spiritual leprosy'. May the good Lord help us to seek His Mercy and Forgiveness at the earliest.







