SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

'How to resist our temptation' is the key topic as this week's gospel from Mark 1:12-15 explores. Apostle James in his letter 1:13-14 makes this strong point: No one, when tempted, should say, "I am being tempted by God; for God cannot be tempted by evil and he himself tempts no one". But one is tempted by one's own desire, being lured and enticed by it. Prof. Dr. Angela Duckworth from the Pennsylvania State University had written about 'resisting our temptations'. According to her, Lent offers a Sacred Time for developing Willpower & Self-control'. She offers three steps to realize Self Control and develop Willpower. 1. Establish Motivation for a change & set goals for transformation. 2. Monitor your behaviors and attitudes towards that goal. 3. Achieve Willpower which will lead to healthy & happy living.

She suggests the following measures for our consideration. a) Eating Habits: Right eating & regular exercise. Alcohol in moderation. Lent is not for dehydration or starvation. It is to develop a plan to have the right amount of food at the right time. Therefore, develop a food plan that fits your needs & lifestyle. Avoiding junk food is essential for a healthy life. Better to avoid harmful drinks which are not healthy and are not beneficial to one's health & wellbeing. b) Losing weight: It does not come automatically. Weight needs to be controlled through regular activities and monitoring our intake habits. Weight loss is good for achieving greater health benefits. It increases our awareness about obesity and related concerns. c) Time Management: Rather than talking endlessly, can we be brief. Serenity of heart and mind is achieved through time management. Not to engage in unproductive talk, especially gossip at this time.

(Pope Francis' advice to practice 'fasting of the tongue' at this time') Apostle James in his letter 3:5-6 writes about the tongue. "The tongue is a small member, yet it boasts of great exploits. How great the forest is set ablaze by a small fire. And the tongue is a fire".

Willpower does not come automatically. We need to strive, learn, and develop over time in order to gain and own it. Willpower is the ability to resist short term temptations (gratifications) for a long-term benefit, says the Professor. Once we have mastered Willpower, we can achieve great things in life. It promotes selfcontrol. It is the ability to resist, withstand and override an unwanted thought, feeling, emotion or impulse. It gives us the ability 'to play cool / keep calm' even in adverse situations, rather than showing how 'hot /troubled' we are emotionally. Conscious, effortful regulation of self through motivation, awareness and goal setting are the themes that the Scripture is advising today. These tenets help us develop a deep and abiding relationship with God and with our communities. We are encouraged to try. Let us make the following prayer our own during this time: 'God give me the courage to change the things, I can. The serenity to keep calm over the things that I cannot and help me to know the difference'.

Psalm 25 Invites us to pray in the following words: "Make me know your ways Lord & Teach me your paths". The 'ways are the disciplines and the paths are the methods of achieving that grace'. Temptation is a 'war between good & evil' (God & evil spirits) The tempter is the evil...Satan, Devil & Evil desire /Lure... Jesus overthrew Satan's empire by his amazing selfcontrol by the grace of God. He did not complain like the Israelites when they were in the desert grumbling, murmuring, and complaining. Today we are given an opportunity to follow the good example of our master. Let us 'repent' to have a change of heart, transformation, and renewal. So that God's grace may flow in us to build up once again the unique and awesome relationship with our God & with our friends & families.
