"This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him!".

Mark 9:2-10

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

This week's Scripture explores the 'inner conflicts of humans' from the background of Abraham, our father in Faith. (Ge 22:1-18) We celebrate Abraham as a 'Biblical Hero', because he responded in a positive way when called him from 'Ur' (Modern Iraq) and told him to migrate to the place of God's choice. (an unknown place). Abraham was told that he would be the father of many nations. He was 75 years old, and God told him that he would bless Abraham with a progeny, as he was childless. But Abraham had to wait for another 25 years to see the birth of his only son Isaac, according to God's promise. When Isaac was 12years of age, God told Abraham (Ge 22:1-2) "Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering".

Even though Abraham was a Biblical Hero, he was to the core a 'real human being' with feelings and emotions like any of us. Certainly, he would have experienced sleepless nights over this untimely command of God. He would have had his mental agony, anguish & struggle. Much the same Sarah might have felt too. Therefore, we would like to reflect on this 'Inner Struggle' of our father in faith today. 'Inner Struggle or Inner Conflict' is a 'private war' one undergoes in his / her heart, mind & soul before a decision is made. Why do we have inner struggle at all? It's a fight between good and evil (right & wrong) For example, like why should we 'love or hate' or a choice to be made between 'strength or weakness'. (Consider the following: 1. Long time relationships are breaking up due to the cold war...love has become cold. 2.Frustration mounting in life over matters that we no longer have control. in unproductive talk, especially gossip at this time.

...like a son or daughter making a wrong decision. 3.Living in fear of the unknown, like what will happen tomorrow especially in the war zones, or the refugees leaving their country in a hurry or the unpredictable situation of the migrants...like acceptance or deportation.

Like the above situations Abraham had his inner struggle /fight when God asked him to move from "Ur'. But he obeyed God and God blessed him. He also waited on God for 25 long years to see his Son Isaac. But when God asked Abraham to sacrifice his Son, Isaac, whom he loved, he was broken into pieces. He had undergone a great pain with inner conflicts, even though he did not express it explicitly. Abraham was hopeful that God would save his face and rescue his son from danger. But he had no clue or clarity until he placed Isaac on the Altar of Sacrifice. Rev. Prof. Rolheiser OMI gives us the following explanation. 'We all dance to the tune of God'. It's God who operates. Our inner conflicts prompt us to dance. The gravity of the matter increases our intensity of dance. Our dance becomes more vibrant under unknown situations. The excruciating pain in his heart at the thought of sacrificing his only Son Isaac might have intensified his inner struggle. He would have been broken, confused, puzzled at this painful thought.

The Young Isaac might have had his own inner struggle too. Isaac asked his father, "Where is the animal for the sacrifice?" (Ge22:7) We have wood & fire, but where is the animal? Abraham was speechless for a brief moment, but diplomatically he answered, "God himself will provide" (Ge 22:8) Yes, God provided. Apostle Paul in his letter to Romans 8:31-32 tells us, "If God is for us, who can be against us?". Are we undergoing inner struggle? Do you have mental and physical tight corners in life? Place your Trust & Confidence in the Lord. He will rescue you from all your miseries, challenges & troubling situations. Like Abraham, we all can become heroes in the sight of the Almighty, provided we trust in him... "My God will Provide & My God will Rescue me from all my challenges".


