#### SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"What is the Message of the Cross?". Apostle Paul in 1 Cor 1:18-25 Explained the message of the Cross in the following phrases: 1. Cross is the Power of God & 2. It is the wisdom of God. Suffering is a great mystery, which is fully expressed in Jesus' Passion. Most moderners think that 'suffering is a mere absurdity' and wish to escape or avoid it. But suffering is inevitable and can't be avoided. God seems to be unjust when we see the suffering of the innocent people especially the Ukrainians, Palestinians, Russians, Hebrews, and the Nicaraguans. But suffering brings healing and comfort to human life.

Suffering of Christ is for the Redemption of the whole human race. The effect of Christ's suffering, death, burial, and resurrection are for the reconciliation and redemption of the human race. Jesus died on the Cross for the restoration of the humans with the god the Father. Paul in Ephesian 2:14 wrote, 'Christ is our PEACE'!'. Christ has brought the Jews and the Greeks together and made them one in him. Through the cross, he won over the hostility that separated humans and brought peace. Since we are justified, we have peace with God. The decisive moment of the divine plan of salvation was achieved through the passion, death, and resurrection of Christ. The story of the Cross makes Christ the Lord of Glory. He was crucified & buried, but God raised him to new life by His Power. According to Paul, our Redemption is the Gratuitous Initiative of the Father, who loves humans despite our failures.

Paul also informs us, the moderners, that the Cross seems to be a 'stumbling block & scandal', as it had been to the Jews, who expected miracles from the Messiah & the Greeks, who longed for Wisdom and Eloquence. The Greeks always gloried in human achievements along with honor and praise.

But Jews and Greeks were blinded to stumble by their own expectations. But Christ manifested the Power and wisdom of God (2 Cor 12:10) My grace is enough for you. In weakness, power reaches its perfection, for "When I am weak then I am strong". The power of Christ crucified makes me strong in my weakness.

According to 1 Cor 2:2 True Wisdom comes from the Cross, which is suffering. Human Wisdom is based on Excellence, Brilliance and superior Activities. But God's Wisdom makes use of the Weakness to manifest His Glory. Worldly wisdom is based on logic/philosophy/ learning. It divides people as learned and ignorant paving ways to social imbalance, division, jealousy & competition. But the Wisdom of the Cross reveals the mindset of God. The mindset of God is non-judgmental and welcoming. It leads to 'spiritual maturity, tolerance & acceptance. We learn the lesson that 'God's standards are quite different from human/worldly standards, which may color our judgement and lead to spiritual immaturity. Whereas the Wisdom of the Cross might appear to be weak and foolish, it gives strength and power to those who believe in its merits.

Encyclopedia Britannica reports that in 519 B.C, King Darius of Persia executed 3000 political prisoners through crucifixion. Emperor Alexander the Great executed 800 jews in Israel through Crucifixion during his time. Therefore, the Cross has come to be known as a Curse for people and everyone was aware of this fact. Jesus himself had been crucified on the Cross & he hung on it (He had been cursed) Paul could not reconcile with this fact as a Jew. But Jesus helped him out when he met Paul on the road to Damascus (Acts 19:1-9) through the spectacular activity of Divine Revelation. Here he came to his senses to understand that the cross, which was an instrument of suffering & curse, has the power to transform hearts, minds and the whole being of people. The Cross, which was a stumbling block for many centuries, has become the real remedy for all our ailments. Let us get attached to the Holy Cross of Christ.


#### Week 3: March 3 Denouncing oil pollution in Nigeria






