SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Jesus was Lifted up" (Jn 13:14-21) on the Cross to give life, health, and wellbeing to those who look at him. Moses, the liberator of the exiled Hebrews, 'lifted a bronze serpent up in the wildernesses to give temporary relief to those who were bitten by the snakes'. (Nu 21:4-9) The serpents were venomous reptiles as their bites cause inflammation. The bite of a serpent would have been painful & deadly especially in olden days (in modern times there are snake bite vaccines available for a cure). So, God ordered Moses to mount a serpent on a pole and help the snake bitten Hebrews to look at that raised serpent. Those who looked at it experienced relief. God raised Christ the Messiah on the Cross to give life (Eternal life). Jesus has the power to heal all our infirmities & ailments including Spiritual ones.

Karen Blixen, an Anglican Theologian from Africa in her book, 'A Shooting Accident' wrote about serpents. In her opinion, in the symbol of the serpent, 'the Hebrews found a temporary relief and comfort despite their discomfort & misfortune'. The Hebrews were bitten by poisonous serpents when they spoke against God & Moses. They said, 'Why did you bring us out of Egypt just to put us to death in the wilderness?... For there's neither water nor bread here. We are sick of this unsatisfying food. At this complaint God sent fiery serpents among the people and were bitten by them. People then came to Moses regretting their mistake and asked him to intercede on their behalf to God. When Moses spoke to God, the Divine directed him to make an image of the serpent in bronze and mount it on a pole for the people to look at. All who looked at that serpent image, regained life and wellbeing.

According to Karen Blixen, some venomous snakes can even kill the elephants within one stroke. According to the amazon News of Snakes, there are about 2900 species of snakes available in the earthly planet and 600 out of them are considered highly venomous. The most venomous / poisonous snakes are found in Australia and called 'Taipan' which are equal to a King Cobra. Other poisonous snakes are 1. Eastern Brown yellow Snake 2. Yellow Bellied Snake 3. The Congo Water Cobra and 4. The Tiger Snake. (Kindly remember that 'snake venom' is used for the cure of cancer according to the medical magazines.

Evangelist John in Chapter 3:14 & 12:32 uses the expression, "When I am lifted up, I will draw all people to myself. Like a magnet that draws all objects to itself, Christ has the power and capacity to draw all humans to His Divine love & mercy, wrote Karen Blixen. 'Did Christ draw all people into his life when he was lifted up?'. Christ lifted up has the Global Potentiality to extend His Reign to everyone. We are invited to be in his team. Are we ready and willing? The World has about 8 billion people as of today. Out of this population, a vast majority follow his path and the rest are in the process of hearing His Sacred Word. It becomes our present responsibility to make Christ known to the World. 'We are invited to impact the World positively to bring them to Christ', requests Pope Francis.






