SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

"Jesus the Grain of Wheat" (Jn 12:20-23) and he (dies) falls into the ground as a single grain. But he Rose again by the Power of God. Grain of Wheat is the thought-provoking metaphor for 'Selfless Love'. It disintegrates in order to sprout out and to produce in abundance. Jesus sacrificed for everyone to live. Selfishness is the human weakness (false love), which will not allow one to sacrifice (selfishness overrides our generosity), which destroys oneself. 'Imitation of Christ' (Phil 2:6), the Servant of God is the much-accepted standard of Christian perfection. As the seed germinates inside the ground, the Word of God that we listen to at every liturgical gathering should stir (ferment & germinate) in the hearts of the believer motivating us for action. This is how the Kingdom of God is sprouting & spreading. As the seed inevitably sprouts and grows to produce either 30, 60, or 100% of grain, the Word of God heard, inevitably will produce a rich/bountiful harvest. (2 Cor 9:10) According to Pope Benedict XVI 'God chose the best of the human Seed in the Person of Christ Jesus, the Messiah and planted him in the human family'. The Pope wrote in his 'Biblical Theology' book, 'Since Christ was the best of seed, he produced a Bumper Harvest, a wonderful crop, in human history. He initiated the way for a 'lasting transformation by his principles of Love of God and neighbour'.

He taught the World, the value system of generosity, unconditional love, non-judgmental attitudes, and interactions. He showed us the method of 'Radical Love' by making everyone important and reaching out to all people without any reservation to share his goodwill. In his life and preaching, he initiated this change, and, in his death, he actually became a source of life giving, a New Beginning to everyone who opts to follow him.

Today's Scriptures honor him remembering his impending death with gratitude. According to Agriculture research, 'every seed has life and potentiality to survive'. So, even when they are buried in the ground, they undergo a slow death, in order to bring out a New Growth. This is what we call 'germination', like wheat grain, apples, or oranges.

Jesus was dead and buried, but in his death, 'He Sprouted' and His movement became a reality through his disciples (Acts 5:38 "This plan or this undertaking is of human origin, it will fall by itself, but if it is of God, you will not be able to overthrow"), who went out to the entire world of that time and propagated his message of this human transformation. The Jewish Leaders and those responsible for the death of Christ thought that with the Burial of Christ, they had put an end to his movement. But before their dream could die, 'Jesus Rose, He Germinated' and challenged them more by his presence and appearances. This is how he strengthened his followers. Today "Jesus Blooms in the Hearts of His Followers'. How fortunate are we to be his present-day disciples, as we near the Holy Week / The Sacred Three Days of our Redemption, let us gratefully acknowledge what Jesus has done for us and develop a deep love for Him & His Church.






