SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

The Centrality of Christian Faith hinges on the Glorious Resurrection of Christ. Resurrection is therefore a 'Fundamental and Essential Witness and Teaching of the Apostolic Faith'. But modern thinkers would like to caption the 'Resurrection of Christ' as an 'apostolic fraud & a fabricated story or a fiction, popularized by the disciples'. The Church treasures the Resurrection of Christ as a historical fact recorded in the history and life of Israel, Palestine, Rome & Greece. The Resurrection of Christ had been lived out in the Early Church by the Disciples of Christ and were recorded by the Evangelists John, Mathew, Luke & Mark.

There were eyewitnesses who had seen the Risen Christ for 40 days after his Resurrection and had testified, especially St. Thomas who said after seeing the Risen Christ, "My God and my Lord". (Jn 20:28) There were Roman Authorities, Jewish Elders, Police personnel and the Common people of that time who had witnessed the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Christ...and had given a Credible Witness to His Resurrection. Finally, the 'empty tomb' of Christ, visited by Mary Magdalene, Peter & John profess their proof even today and wondered about seeing the Angels who announced the Resurrection of Christ, "Why do you search for the living among the dead. He is Risen" (Mt 28:5 & Lk 24:5)

Apostle Paul in his first letter to the Corinthians 15:20 wrote, "If Christ had not been risen, our preaching is useless, and your believing is futile". He believed that Christ had been raised. Resurrection is the activity of God. Christ had been raised to be the 'Lord of the Universe' and in his letter to the Philippians 2:1-11 We are reminded by Paul that all of us should kneel to adore Christ, when we hear his Holy Name'.

Therefore, the Resurrection of Christ is not a fabricated or concocted story, rather it is a Historical fact, a reality and we are fortunate today to Celebrate with Great Jubilation 'The Resurrection of Our Redeemer'. Easter Celebrates His Glorious "New Life" (His rising from death). Jesus was not 'Resuscitated'. He did not go into 'a coma & come back alive'. Rather he died on the Cross & 'God Raised Him from the Dead'. (Acts 4:10) We are fortunate to Profess this Easter Faith today with millions and millions of people around the World!


