## SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

Pentecost Celebrates the 'Birthday of the Church'. Pentecost is celebrated after 50 days of Easter (The Resurrection of Christ). It celebrates the 'Outpouring of the Spirit' by God the Father and Jesus Christ His Son. The Holy Spirit is the 'Gift of the Father & the Son'. He is also known as the 'Spirit of Truth'. He leads and guides the church through the Apostolic College. Pentecost is Celebrated after 50 days of Easter. The Holy Spirit is the one who sanctifies the believing community through various ministries... as it is stated in 1Cor 12:4-6 "There is a variety of gifts but always the same spirit, there are all sorts of service to be done, but always the same Lord, working in all sorts of different ways in different people, it is the same God who is working in all of them".

The Jewish people 'Celebrated the Feast of Weeks', an agricultural feast (like our Canadian Thanksgiving Day) thanking God for the rich harvest & bumper crop... the first fruit of the earth. The Book of Deuteronomy 16:10 Explained the Jewish feast of Thanksgiving. It was celebrated 50 days after the Passover feast. On this day, according to Jewish history, Moses the lawgiver received the TWO Stone Tablets containing the 10 Commandments from God. The Sinai Theophany (Ex 19:1-25) had loud noise of thunder and lightning like the modern-day crackers making a huge noise...when Moses received the Stone Tablets and smoke was emanating from the rocks. These natural elements were attributed in the Reception of the Holy Spirit by the Apostles of Christ.

On the day of Pentecost, the Apostles received the Holy Spirit when they were assembled in prayer. They experienced a violent rushing wind, tells Acts 2:1-47.

Flames of fire rested on the heads of the Apostles, and they spoke in tongues. (Holy Spirit is understood in the following symbols (Dove, Wind & Flames of Fire) Holy Spirit gives us the following gifts (Gal 5:22-23) such as, speaking in tongues, giving joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, trustfulness, gentleness, and selfcontrol. The Holy Spirit builds up the Christian Community. Jesus is the Architect (1 Cor 3:5ff) and We, the faithful people of God are the builders (the living stones (1 Pt 2:6) making this spiritual house...with the Apostles and the Faithful. We are the Church, and we build this Church with the Value systems of Christ (Love of God and Neighbour), with the hope of achieving His Promised ideal "Eternal Life", through our lively participation. The Spirit makes this diverse group that is spread out in all the continents of the World speaking varied languages as ONE, Catholic & Universal Church, uniting us all in the One Spirit & One Baptism to Worship the Triune God....under the banner of the Cross of Christ! It gives us the ability to call God, "Abba Father" (Rm 8:15-16) in our Unity and in our Diversity, giving a Credible Witness to His Glorious Resurrection!




