#### Scripture Message

Ascension Celebrates Jesus being taken up to Heaven (Acts 1:1-11) "Heaven is the Kingdom of the Father" (Mt13:43), where the virtuous will 'Shine like the Sun' in the Kingdom of the Father. But heaven is not above the earth. It is the presence of God that makes Heaven possible & a reality. According to Paul, "Heaven is where Justice, Peace and Love" are experienced (Rm 14:17) Heaven is therefore an experience of the Divine by the people of God = the Redeemed Community of Christ. Heaven is the Promised Land where the believers are intimately realizing their intimacy with the Divine...which we call Eternal Life. Christ ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives according to the Scriptures. The Mount of Olives is in Galilee. Heaven is not a Physical Place. It's a Spiritual Concept, where the righteous people behold God face to face. Paul in Romans 1:16 -17 tells us that 'it is the power of God saving all who have faith - Jews first, but Greeks as well, since this is what reveals the Justice of God to us: It shows how faith leads to faith, or as Scripture says: "The upright finds life through faith". The Ascension of the Lord Jesus took place after 40

days of his Resurrection. According to the Book of Leviticus 23:15-22 Forty Days would be a symbolic Number (to offer Yahweh a New Oblation = first fruits of the earth, Sacred Assembly to be Convened = Day of Atonement (Lev 16) and Care of the Poor. Christian people all over the world have observed 40 days of preparation for Easter through Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. . We also celebrated the Sacred Three Days = Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil. Like the Israelites who celebrated their 'Feast of the Weeks' (Harvest Festival) for Seven weeks, (40 days), with

Pilgrimages to the Jerusalem Temple. We have, similarly celebrated Christ's Glorious Resurrection over sin and Death for the past 40 days and have made special Pilgrimages during this Jubilee Year to Holy Places in atonement for our own failures and weaknesses.

We are glad today to celebrate the Ascension of Christ. The solemnity of Ascension celebrates Jesus' being seated at the 'Right Hand of God' (Psalm 110:1 "Yahweh's oracle to you, my Lord, "Sit at my right hand and I will make your enemies a footstool for you") At his Holy Birth, Jesus, the second person of the Holy Trinity divested his glory and took on the form of Human Flesh to be born as a human child. Today, the Feast of Ascension glorifies Celebrating Jesus, the Servant of God, (Second Person of the Holy Trinity) being taken up to Heaven and Seated at the Right Hand of God, as King of the Universe. He will bestow forgiveness and repentance for those who call upon his name. St. Paul wrote in Philippians 2:6-11 "God raised him high and gave him the name which is above all other names. So that all beings in the Heavens, on earth and in the underworld, should bend the knee at the Name of Jesus and that every tongue should acclaim, Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father". The Church is grateful to celebrate Jesus' continual Presence even today in our midst by the outpouring of the Spirit. It's a happy occasion for us to Celebrate the Solemnity of Ascension as our 'World Communication Day'. Jesus is inviting all of us to promote the gospel values to the ends of the earth through our honorable living and lively faith initiatives!


