Scripture Message

St. Thomas Becket celebrated 'The Feast of the Trinity' in England between 1118-1170 according to Church History. Pope John XXII (1316-34) gave permission for the Universal Church to Celebrate this Solemnity. According to the Church Historians Tertulian and Origen (150-225 A.D) this expression, "One God in Three Persons" came into being. These two prolific writers were considered the 'Pillars' of this doctrine. They gave a strong foundation for the Holy Trinity = God is Family. Humans are made in the likeness and image of God. (Ge2:26) "Let us make humans in our image and likeness". Pope John Paul II was of the view that Trinity has 'Genuine Love, Respect & Mutual Acceptance". The Three Persons of the Trinity = Father, Son & The Spirit, have mutual interaction without any interference. They still work together, cooperate in all matters. Our family should be modelled on the "Holy Trinity" to have Genuine Love / Authentic Love between spouses & among the members of the household = the family. We need to express our love through our life, care and existence to achieve this great concept.

Pope Francis was reminding us of the 'throw away culture' in our modern society, which goes against this moral & spiritual principle of the Holy Trinity....What is not useful should be discarded or thrown away...(Especially our elders and our children & so on) along with the Changing Culture of the Society, which is increasingly moving towards Secularism devoid of Religion. According to today's Gospel (Jn 16:12-15) The Holy Spirit is the gift of the Father & the Son. The Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Trinity.

It's the Spirit of Truth, which is the gift of the Father & Son, who continues the Redemptive activity of Christ through the Church.

Though unseen, yet the Spirit is very alive, vibrant and active to channelize and guide our deliberations: Acts 15 & Galatians 3 The Jerusalem Council)

Wisdom is attributed to the Divinity. (Pro 1:7) "The awe-inspiring Presence of God is the Beginning of Wisdom". This wisdom comes from God himself as per Proverbs 8:22-31 It is the Lord who grants this Wisdom. We need to acquire wisdom through 'diligence'. Wisdom is manifested in Excellence! Wisdom of God played a significant role in the Creation. God was the Chief Architect, Craftsman and Builder. 'Wisdom is God's Child' (Ps 139:22) Paul Wrote in 1 Cor 1:23 "Jesus Christ is the Power and Wisdom of God". Wisdom pleases God (1Jn8:29) and Wisdom finds delight in God. Wisdom of God is revealed in the 'suffering and death of Jesus Christ on the Cross'. All those who believe in the Holy Wisdom of God are justified, wrote St. Paul in Romans 5:1-5 'Justification is our Salvation' which is achieved through our participation in the suffering, death and resurrection of Christ. The Risen Christ influences our Justification through Reconciliation = Peace is the Divine Favour & Grace of Christ. Peace is the gift of the Risen Christ (Jn14:27) which leads to the Divine Presence. Peace gives Hope. Hope is the gratuitous gift of God ="Faith is the assurance of the things hoped for". (Heb 11:1) Even in our troubles we hope for better things to happen. 'This Hope develops Our Christian Confidence'. May this Hope always sustain us through our deep and abiding love of the Trinity.
