

SCRIPTURE MESSAGE

Prophet Ezekiel was a Prophet of Israel during the Babylonian exile (593-571 BCE) His message was that '(Yahweh) God of Israel cannot abandon his people, because He is the next of kin to Israel (go-el) Yahweh (God) redeems his people not because they repented, but because of His Holy Name, which caused Him to enter into a covenant with them and that will now cause Him to restore them. Ezekiel was one among the exiles. God Called and Commissioned him to be His mouthpiece and gave him Vision (inspiration) to help out His people. God's Spirit entered the heart of Ezekiel the prophet and empowered / strengthened him to be His mouthpiece for His people. The Spirit of God made Ezekiel conscious of & be attentive to God's promptings. The prophet is advised to 'Stand up'. (V2)..to be conscious of being moved by the Spirit of God to speak the Truth & Conscientize the people of the reality. People might ignore and turn a deaf ear to the message of the Prophet because the words of the prophet would be harsh, but they cannot be taken lightly or ignored. The Psalm 123 Expresses this sentiment that Israelites themselves sought the way of the Lord through the Prophet, as the Prophet himself looked towards the Lord for directions. Israelites looked eagerly for the Lord's guidance to lead them when they were in exile and after their release So Lord Released them from their captivity and settled them in their own bountiful land.

The Israelites had to endure the pain of exile all through their existence (Ps 137) as a 'Thorn in their flesh' (2 Cor 12: 7-10) which is incurable, challenging and cumbersome. Israel even today undergoes this painful situation in our modern history.

Persecution, shooting & shelling have become the unpredictable predicament & order of their existence. These afflictions reduce their physical and moral strength. When Jesus underwent such a situation in the garden of Gethsemane, He cried out, (Mk 14:36) "Abba Father, for you all things are possible; Remove this cup from me, yet, not what I want, but what you want". His Father God answered, "My Grace is enough for you (2 Cor 12:9) For power is made perfect in weakness". Our prayers are answered by Jesus (Divine Providence) when we bear our afflictions & shortcomings for the sake of the Love of Christ. For when are weak with all these hurts and criticisms which are incurable often times, but when we bear them for the sake of Christ with resignation, he Strengthens us with His Divine Power as the Psalm 18 reinforces that He is our Strength, Fortress & Rock & in Him We Trust.

In our modern world 'family union' (marriage) quite often does not seem to be going well. Today's gospel (Mk 6:1-6) asks this beautiful question: "Is it lawful for someone to divorce?". We hold the Sacrament of Marriage as a Sacred Institution, which promotes the human relationship and helps families through the shared love of the man and woman to form families through the procreation of children / offsprings. It is a Sacred Union and not a plaything of time. It is not based on the convenience of the parties. It is a serious commitment which insists on the loyalty & truthfulness of the parties concerned to sustain and remain in a lasting relationship. (Genesis 1:27 & 2:24 Affirm that Marriage is a Permanent institution (Indissoluble) Spouses become bone of my bone and flesh of my flesh by their commitment and relationship. But this Sacred union suffers seriously in our modern civilization. Some families/parties may experience the untimely thorn of divorce/separation creeping in their relationship causing mental challenges. Take it to the Lord in prayer and the Lord Jesus can help with your situation because he said, "My Grace is enough for you". Bring your pain and turmoil to his attention. He will give you a way out. May the good lord Bless all our Parish Families!
