PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Mountain Top Experience is very special. Mountain Climbers try their best to reach the top of 'The Everest' one of the tallest in the World. Most people find climbing very tough. Oftentimes people require skill, stamina, company, supplies for sustenance & adaptability to the changing climatic conditions to climb. Ancients climbed the mountains to explore & experience 'Spirituality' in the mountain tops. There are ruined ancient temples and caves in the world that give us a sense of appreciation for such Spiritual Quest of people.

Moses, the law giver, was said to have climbed Mount Zion, The Mountain of the Lord, on the Invitation of God ("Yahweh called Moses to the top of the Mountain and Moses went up" Ex 19:20) Mountain was considered to be a Sacred Place ('Take care not to go up the mountain or to touch the foot of it' (Ex 19:12) Moses encountered God in the 'Burning Bush' (Ex 3:3) and developed a taste to go up to the mountain to consult God. The Prophet Elijah was hiding in the mountain when he was escaping for his life (1Kg 19:9-18) But God visited Elijah to give His Support, Hope and Encouragement. Elijah encountered God in the 'Gentle Breeze' (1 Kgs19:13) and returned to his ministry. 'Mount Carmel' in Israel is a living sign of God's Presence and Elijah fostered his Contemplative Spirituality from this Sacred Place.

Abraham was drawn to God at the age of 75 (Ge 12:1-4) and he experienced the 'Saving Power of the Divine' when he underwent a challenge in his life. (Childless, Unplanned Migration & Sacrifice of Isaac) But Abraham was able to perceive the 'Divine Initiative' through his transition & obedience. Abraham migrated according to God's wish to the land of 'milk and honey' (Israel) and God blessed his descendants

with land & progeny. Abraham has been acclaimed to be our father in faith (Heb 11:1-40) The Divine, conned his spirituality to give us an example. Therefore, the Prophet Ezekiel was able to guide us develop our own spirituality. (Eze 36:26) "Developing a New Heart & New Mind" to follow the guidance of the Lord. This is rooted in making a transition from our old ways to a new, transformative state of life in the Presence of the Divine.

The Transfiguration of Jesus at Mt. Tapore (Mt 17:1-9) changed the perception of his inner circle (Peter, James and John) totally and completely. They have been enthused to view Jesus' Glory as an Earthly Messiah' as narrated in Ex: 43:29-35 'that Moses face was brightened by a dazzling light', Elijah was taken up into heaven in a fiery chariot (2 Kgs 2:12) Jesus was transfigured. remember But let us that 'Transfiguration is a Mystical Experience', which transforms our life. The Disciples of Christ saw the Lawgiver, Moses & the Prophet Elijah in their vision. At the Mountain of Tapore, Jesus revealed His True identity, "The Suffering Servant' (Is 42:1 & 53: 1-13) The transfiguration of Christ transformed their thinking and helped to develop a deeper spiritual understanding of him as the Son of God, the Lawgiver & Prophet. Mathew, the Evangelist affirmed Jesus' Sonship and Messiahship'.




DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE

The visually-stunning film is directed by Englishman Nicolas Brown (two-time Emmy winner) and co-produced by Off the Fence (winner of the Oscar for best documentary 2021 for "My Octopus Teacher") and the Laudato Si' Movement.


