PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"Give me a drink" (Jn 4:7) Jesus asked the Samaritan woman. "Why did you lead us out of Egypt, only to bring us to this wretched place? It is a place unfit for sowing, it has no figs, no vines, no pomegranates and there is not even water to drink!" (Numbers 20: 5) "Sir, said the Samaritan woman, 'give me some of that water, so that I may never get thirsty and never have to come here again to draw water" (Jn 4:15)

Today's scriptures speak about 'water'(H2O) Medical manuals codify the importance of water for human survival. 60% of the human body contains water. Water regulates our internal body temperature by sweating and perspiration. Human body's major systems like heart, brain, lungs and kidneys depend on water to function and survive. WHO reports that 780 Million people do not have access to fresh & clean water for their consumption. 97% of the ground water is salty. 3% of the water is stored in the Glaziers.

The water reserve in the world is decreasing causing concern for the WHO. 'Water will run out faster than oil' some modern thinkers caution. Let us remember that 'Water is a human right'. But water has become a threatened natural resource in the Global South. People walk miles and miles to fetch a pot of water in the drought-borne areas. Govts spend enormous sums of money to dig or deepen tube-wells for providing water for their citizens.

According to the Hebrews/Israelites "Torah is the Living Water" (the first 5 Books of Moses i.e 1.Genesis 2.Exodus 3.Leviticus 4.Numbers & 5. Deuteronomy) It's the treasure from which God gives water for the people to lead a 'Diligent & Dignified Life'. The Book of Numbers 20:2-10 explained how God gave water from the Rock when they grumbled for water in the wilderness.

This water is given to everyone from His Treasures, who seeks Him in their need. God gives this water (Grace) from His Goodness, whenever His people are challenged with unforeseen concerns and burdens. This water is Divine Vitality, Divine Revelation and Divine Wisdom (Grace) which bestows on us insight and inner vision for enlightenment.

The Book of Sirach 24:20 reminds, "The drinker of this water (Wisdom) will thirst again and again'. (The desire for Divine Wisdom is unquenchable) For Christians, "Jesus is the Living Water". Because of His suffering and death on the cross, he nourished / nourishes His people, from His open side, from where this water proceeds (Jn 19:34) This water opens a pathway to our Spiritual Experience, (Ps15 & 24) making us New Creatures (2 Cor 5:7) giving us the Hope of Eternal Life & Immortality. Let us thirst for this water all through our Christian existence.




