### PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"Our bones are dried up; our hope has gone; we are as good as dead" (Ezekiel 37:12) "Can these bones live?" bones' (Eze 37:3)'Dry symbolize 'Hopelessness'. The book of Genesis 2:23 Explained: "This at last is bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh". The expression 'bones' symbolize, 1. Strength 2. Stamina 3. Vitality, which enables humans to stand up and face their challenges in life. (Ps 6:3) "Pity me God, I have no strength left, heal me, my bones are in torment, my soul is in utter torment". Job 4:14 "A shiver of horror ran through me, and my bones quaked with fear" & Is 38:13 "Like a lion, he crushes my bones". These expressions reveal when people experience discouragement, enslavement, or an untold misery like the exiled people of Israel /Ukraine. They feel the lifelessness and the catastrophic situation they undergo.

Ezekiel 37:3 asks, "Can these bones live?". Hosea 6:3 answers, "Yahweh / God will bring us back to life, on the third day, He will raise us" and Isaiah 26:19 Promises: " Your dead will come to life. This corpse will rise, awake, and exult, all who lie in the dust and the land of the ghosts will give birth". This is the hope we have in Christ. God will raise them from their graves in order to live with Him eternally in His Presence. (We will have the experience of Paradise, Bliss & Salvation) God can raise people from their graves in order to give New Hope, New Life, New Enthusiasm, New Purpose through His Life-Giving Spirit "Breath of God" (Ge 1: 7) " God breathed into humans' nostrils, a breath of life, and they became a living being". ('Graves' is a metaphor for 'Captivity' & the hope, that God will bring them out of their miserable existence, giving them New Hope) How do we get into the situation of dry bones/ hopelessness?

Almost everyone experiences unexpected or sudden challenges such as misfortunes like the Ukrainian people or the several Asian & African people taking hazardous voyages seeking better living conditions or like the people who flock the US borders to get in, for new life. What about the sudden death of our loved ones, loss of a lucrative employment or business, thriving enterprise, untimely change in the family dynamics, break of marriage, sickness, children running away from home & so on. When peoples' hope is robbed, they become 'dry bones'...and experience the loss of vitality, strength and stamina. Our faith community is invited by the Scriptures today to give such people hope, encouragement and boost their morale.

Let's consider the situation of the world for the last few years, due to Corona Virus. It has crippled so many lives, families, economies, factories & industries. So many families are displaced, lost their loved ones, including our best health personnel & healthcare professional.

The Church also has lost so many good & faithful people including several nuns, religious workers and clergy. The church has lost very many of her sons and daughters who went into the frontline to support and care for the vulnerable people. The scriptures extend an invitation at this time to all the living not to give-up the hope, but to rely on the power of God, to make all things new in Christ. Living and Caring in the Spirit of Christ, gives vitality to the community.

All the baptized Christians, who dwell in the Spirit of the Living God, should be able to install this hope and encouragement for the people who experience dry bones in their life. The Spirit of God guides our human efforts & conduct. The Spirit of God and the Spirit of Christ should impel us to action and participate in this noble gesture of rebuilding the lives of our people through our timely care, giving them sure hope and encouragement. Let's make a difference and walk extra miles to make this vision of the Scripture a reality in our time.



#### **DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE**

Through their prayer, fasting and almsgiving during Lent, Christians express their desire to turn toward God and to all God's children in preparation for Easter. The Bishops of Canada have reserved the Season of Lent for a collection to assist the Global South. Normally this collection is held on the Fifth Sunday of Lent. On the day of the collection, an appropriate petition may be added to the Prayer of the Faithful.

Founded and mandated in 1967 by the Bishops of Canada, and now a member of the Caritas International network of Catholic agencies, the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace financially supports development and aid projects in Africa, Asia, the Middle East, Latin America and the Caribbean, as well as informs Canadian Catholics on international social justice questions.

"So many people even today hope to have enough to eat. The planet has food for all, but the will to share with everyone seems to be lacking. To prepare the table for all, and to ask that there be one table for all. Doing whatever we can so that everyone has food, but also reminding the world's powerful that God will call them to be judged one day, and it will be demonstrated whether they have truly tried to provide food for Him in each person (cf. Mt 25.35) and whether they have acted in order that the environment would not be destroyed but would be able to produce this food?" POPE FRANCIS, Homily during the Mass at the opening of the 2015 General Assembly of Caritas Internationalis.


