PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Passion Sunday introduces the excruciating walk that Jesus undertook on the road to Calvary, having the heavy Cross on his shoulders. He walked barefoot, and with a heavy heart. He was fragile, yet he manifested courage. He fell three times under the heavy weight of the cross but got up again and again to continue the walk until the finish line. He died a valiant death.

As we look forward to walking with him fully, we are reflecting this journey of Christ. We ask him grace to walk with him up to the finish line. We may have our own challenges in life, both personal and public, but we wish to walk with the Lord, asking him to give us courage, strength and stamina to carry on this walk without interruption. (No turning back) On our way to Calvary, we would be connecting with several of our humankind, who may be having simi-

several of our humankind, who may be having similar challenges like our own in life. Everyone's life situation seems to be different, but the intensity of the pain and the feeling of despair might be the same. The agony of each one's heart is known to God alone. In our distress we cry within our hearts for God's help that He may be able to save us from our miserable existence.

Jesus felt abandoned and forsaken at the face of his heavy cross and the winding road ahead of his walk. (When I was in Jerusalem, I walked this road with the Cross on my shoulders. It was the most humbling experience I ever had in my entire life. It was a grace filled moment for me. I might cherish this feeling as long as God allows me to live in this world & even beyond the grave. Certainly, it was a wonderful moment of grace in my life).

Jesus might have prayed the Psalm 22 "My God, my God, Why did you abandon me". God never abandons his loved ones. But the sufferer feels that way when the pain and anguish is unbearable

& un-shareable. We all have this miserable feeling that God has not responded to our pleas when we needed him most. We feel abandoned and forsaken. (Reading and reflecting Psalm 88 will be beneficial for those who feel their intense abandonment)

But let us remember that God never leaves or abandons us. He is always there for us, and He walks with us in our moments of grief and pain. The Prayer Card "Foot-Prints" by an Unknown Author reminds: 'My Child, I love you. I would never leave you. During your difficult time of trial and suffering, I carried you on my shoulders'. So, be consoled and get attached to me all the more. Let us know the nearness & the closeness of the Lord in all our turmoil and painful situations that we pass through in this life.




